## **Section I. Issues**

The station has identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- Louisiana's COVID-19 Economic Shutdown & Reopening: Louisiana was one of the hardest hit, and first states, to deal with COVID-19. The state went into full "Stay At Home" Lockdowns, before slowly lifting into a 3-Phase reopening. We've staying in constant contact with the Governor's Office and Louisiana Department of Health to inform our audience of the guidelines, and what to expect during the closures and reopening process. As the state saw declines in numbers after the vaccine rollout started, we saw more and more openings. Along with much more optimism about the post-COVID future.
- COVID-19 Vaccine Rollouts and Expansion: The COVID-19 vaccine rollout in Northwest Louisiana really ramped up in early 2021. As the vaccine rollout started, and expanded, we talked to those in charge every step of the way. From state representatives with the Louisiana Department of Health, to the leaders at LSU Health who were facilitating the area's mass vaccination site, we heard all of the details on a regular basis.
- Local COVID-19 Capacity and Treatment Concerns: Before the vaccine rollout started helping to pull the COVID numbers back in the state, our region was dealing with a surge in hospital capacity and treatment needs.
- Winter Weather: Our region dealt with two snow storms to start the year, both leaving accumulating snow, which is very uncommon for our area. But the second storm also brought ice and sub-zero temperatures. Leading to deadly outcomes in our area.
- Shreveport City Reform: From bond issues to marijuana decriminalization, the City of Shreveport debated some large scale issues in the first part of 2021. We spoke with city leaders about the changes they were proposing, and how the city would execute these possible changes in the future.
