Section I. Issues.

The Station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- H. Family Values:** An Important Issue, in a moral declining community
- Crime:** The always increasing crime rate

Section II. Responsive Programs.

A. Bible:

“Old Testament Reading”- A 5-15 minute Scripture reading by Alexander Scourby
2 full chapters are read. It goes through the entire old testament every year.

“Hourly Station ID Bible Verse”- A bible verse read for the time or criteria of the day. This is in conjunction with the hourly legal station ID.

B. News

“Back to Genesis”- a one minute program from Institute of Creation Research. Played five days a week at 8:45 AM and 8:45 PM. It contain a truth of science as also taught if you go “Back To Genesis”.

“Answers In Genesis”- Also a one minute program by creationist Ken Ham. Almost the same thing as back to Genesis. Its broadcast at 6:30 AM and 3:00 PM. This is played five days a week.

“Science, Scripture and Salvation”- By Institute of Creation Research. This program is a detailed, scientific and true report of creation, Bible, history and research. John Morris keeps christian up to date with the latest news. This program is aired on Saturdays at 1:00 PM and 8:00 PM

“Voice of the Martyrs”- By Ted Neddleton. This program is a news documentary about various missionary from other parts of the world. This program is aired on Saturdays at 7:00 PM.

C: Military/Government

“David Bercot”- This program aired at 9:00 AM and PM By David Bercot teaches the best way a christian should think about the government. He talks about kingdoms, wars, church movements, etc. David has been studying early church history for many years.

D: Everyday Living:

“Bennett Creek Church”- This is a church service form a local church. Pastor Kurt is an interesting speaker who always uses everyday illustrations to Godly living. It is broadcast on Saturdays and Sundays in the morning and evening.

“Sowing The Seed”- Everyday a program by pastor Ron Ralph teaches holy living.

E. Juvenile Rehabilitation:

“Family Altar”- At 7:30 AM and 10:00 PM Lester Roloff teaches on holy living. It is geared toward youth especially relating toward the worldly lost sinners.

F: Children Stories:

“Adventures In Odyssey”- On Saturday mornings this story is uplifting for the children.

“Children Bible Hour”- This short program, also played on Saturday morning, gives a dramatized story to children. This story always end with a important life lesson.

“The Legal Alert” - Five days a week David Gibbs Jr. gives a helpful tip about what Christian should do in a legal situation.
