**Public Affairs Programming Topics for Quarter 3 2021**

July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Mayor Omar Neil**, former Mayor of Tuskegee Alabama and nephew of Freddie Lee Tyson, a Participant in the Tuskegee syphilis study along with **Michelle Hillman** the Ad council Director of project development on their new initiative Tuskegee Legacy Stories, a Campaign that partners with the survivors of the Tuskegee syphilis study to convince people in the Black community that the vaccine is safe.

**Jarred Moskowitz**, former director for the Florida division of Emergency Management addresses preparedness for things like the deadly condo collapse North of Miami.

July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Vivian Smith Carter**, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist and State of Alabama Project Coordinator for Alabama Apart Together explains what her organization does to help all Alabamians effected psychologically by the Pandemic. She also addresses the new concern over the prevalence of the Variant.

July 18<sup>th</sup> 2021

**Dr. Additi Narukar** Physician with Harvard Medical College and dierector for the Harvard clinical partnership: What is the state of the Pandemic and what can be done about the Nationwide Outbreaks we are now seeing. Dr. Narukar says the blame lines at the feet of those who have vaccine residency. She thinks Booster Shots may also be necessary.

July 25<sup>th</sup> 2021

Author **Rashad Tobacowalla** futurist discusses how businesses and education institutions need to navigate the new post Covid world when it comes to work flow, and work place culture. He also addresses the needs of populations that may be in danger of being left behind.

August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

**US Surgeon General Vivic Murthy** will discuss the rapid increase in Covid 19 and calls for an “all-in” moment for the nation to face the realities presented by this

Pandemic which transcend that which we have already faced. Murthy discusses the new Delta Variant and the CDC's new mask mandate.

August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021

The latest on the state of the pandemic including what you need to know about the rise of the Delta Variant . **Dr. John Brooks** Chief Medical officer for the CDC's Emergency response office addresses concern over breakthrough cases, and cases that are surging among the unvaccinated.

August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Susan Angelo** Program Director with Interiors for Heroes is joining with Lettermen of the USA (lotusa.org) and collaborating with the Salvation Army and the VA system to furnish and decorate apartments for veterans who are overcoming homelessness, having recently completed a rehab/recovery program through the Tuscaloosa Salvation Army Shelter. Susan explains what the program is about, how people can help and also tells us about a project they are finishing in Tuscaloosa this weekend.

August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021

**Ron Shoe** and **Andrew Burk** from Birmingham Based SIP Oasis and **Ana Price** from Insurance Facilities explain the new dangers that loom from cyber security issues in the wake of the Colonial Pipeline hack back in June. Ron and Andrew explain why it is so important to practice password Hygiene. Then Ana Price explains the roll that Cyber security insurance plays in our new digital world.

August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Dr. Lenard Weather** The Former President of the National Medical Association, on the impact of the delta variant on those who are vaccinated as well as those who are not. Then BBC's Forgan correspondent **David Lyon** and the author of the long war: the inside story on the US Afghanistan conflict.

September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Christina Jones** Chief marketing officer for SalesForce.org, an organization that works to make the world a better place through technology focused on stemming income inequality and health equity in marginalized communities.

As well as **Tori Clark** who was working with Don Rumsfeld in the Pentagon when the plane hit that building. Then **Shelly Sunsein** host of the 911 stories podcast on the iHeart Radio AP, talks with NYPD Detective **Scott Strauss** about the people who are still missing from that day.

September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Lisa Skinner**, behavioral expert in the field of Alzheimer's disease and related dementias and author of the book "Truth Lies and Alzheimer's, its secret faces". She seeks to dispel misconceptions about the disease and raise awareness.
