AS A COMMUNITY RADIO STATION, PLEASE FEEL FREE TO SHARE YOUR OPINION - THAT'S A BIG PART OF WHAT WE DO. BUT, FREE SPEECH ALSO COMES WITH RESPONSIBILITY. PLEASE DO NOT USE ANY PROFANE LANGUAGE, PEJORATIVE PHRASES, RACIST, BIGOTED OR SEXIST TERMINOLOGY. YOU DO HAVE THE RIGHT TO YOUR OPINIONS, BUT THAT DOES NOT MEAN YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE TAKEN SERIOUSLY, OR THAT YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO USE THE AIRWAVES FOR YOUR OWN INFLAMMATORY OPINIONS.

MY "LITMUS TEST" FOR A CALL IS THAT IF I WOULD BE EMBARRASSED TO HAVE MY DEAR DEPARTED MOTHER OR DEAR AUNT MADGE HEAR IT, THEN, NO, I DON'T WANT TO HEAR IT AND YOUR POTTY BRAIN IS OF LITTLE ATTRACTION TO OUR WONDERFUL LISTENERS AND MEMBERS.

WHEN "CITIZEN LAKE" TAKES CALLS, PLEASE DO HAVE YOUR SAY. BUT REMEMBER, THIS ISN'T "FOX NEWS" OR "JERRY SPRINGER", AND JUST BECAUSE YOU HEARD IT ON THE INTARWEBS DOESN'T MAKE IT SO, AND SIMPLY BECAUSE YOU BELIEVE IT TO BE SO, DOESN'T MAKE IT SO.
