During the gold rush the trail was used to haul freight, mining equipment, supplies, and people to Deadwood. This was followed by the settlers and home setters. It is thought that the use of the trail was discontinued in 1908. Riders experienced a once in a lifetime ride that hasn't been ridden in 100 years.
