Deadwood Seven Down Regulators is a club, which has 24 members, and they are affiliated with the Single Action Shooting Society. The group uses pistols/rifles/shotguns that are consistent with the 1890s-1900s to shoot at stationary targets that are set up on "stage". Seven Down likes to dress up in historical clothing (cowboys and cowgirls of the Old West); they hold monthly matches on the first Sunday of the month. They will be hosting the SD State Championship in June. The people are down to earth and truly enjoy this fast growing sport. Everyone has an alias and goes by that name during all matches.

Covered Wagon Caravan (Andersen) Various

Stan Smebakken is 70 years old and was born in Lemmon SD. He is planning to cross SD from Minnesota boarder to the Montana border in a small home built covered wagon pulled by horses. A lot of people are interested in joining him with packhorses and other wagons and buggies for part of the trip.

Re-Photographing (Patten) Black Hills

Paul has been re-photographing many historic sites dating from 1875 to the 1930s. Over the past couple years he has reviewed at least 50,000 historic photos in some 25 public and private collections across the state. The images show most existing Black Hills towns and cities, as well as places, which existed at one time but are "gone" today. He started the process of re-photographing locations from the same position used by the earlier photographer, and will be working on this project intensively over the next 12 months. His goal is a publication of a new book in 2006 entitled "The Black Hills Yesterday & Today".
