ISSUE: Self-Improvement through Religion

PROGRAM TITLE: “What’s Up, Utah?”

SYNOPSIS:

1. April 27th and 29th

Jaren Davis, author of “The Bracelet,” discussed the experiences leading up to the writing of the book, and the author’s desire to help readers with the hope of this story.

2. May 4th and 6th

Steve Peterson, local coordinator for the National Day of Prayer, told about activities relating to the National Day of Prayer in Utah.

3. May 18th and 20th

The host discussed with Steve Peterson, co-host, the predictions of Harold Camping about the supposed imminent end of the world.

4. June 8th and 10th

The host interviewed Tyler Measom and Joe Broadbent, director and star of the documentary “Sons of Perdition,” about their experiences filming the documentary and problems with the FLDS group of Colorado City.

5. Rob Harter, director of the Park City Christian Center, a non-denominational resource facility, discussed how it works with local churches and other organizations, including the mayor, to meet the needs of the community.
