

ISSUES AND PROGRAM LISTS FOR 4th QUARTER 2013

“What’s Up Utah” a weekly half-hour program hosted by Greg Johnson, is directed toward the needs and concerns of our Utah Community. The program airs twice per week Wednesdays at 10:30pm and Friday 7:00pm. During the 4th Quarter of 2013 these were among the subjects discussed: issues of parenting and raising a family here in Utah...an interview with the State’s Attorney General John Swallow about what his office does and how his work affects the people of Utah...a conversation with the leading Catholic Bishop for Utah about the Catholic community’s concerns and issues here in Utah... a discussion of the increasing problem of teenage illegal drug use in the Salt Lake Valley and how parents need and can get involved.

The Week of October 9 and 16, 2013

Steve James was the guest who represented the wife of Utah Governor Gary Herbert who sponsors a yearly seminar and conference, “Uplift Families”, dealing with parenting and family issues and to “promote happiness, prosperity and societal stability through strong families and meaningful parent-child relationships”. The annual event has multiple local family experts present symposiums dealing with numerous issues of interest and concern to local parents and to united parents with resources and strategies to aid in achieving the ultimate goal: raising reliable, caring children. Steve talked with Greg about the conference seminars and content and encouraged all viewing parents to attend.

The Week of October 23 and 30, 2013

This week Greg interviewed Lynn Wilder who is a former Mormon and BYU Professor. Lynn is on a book tour releasing her new book Unveiling Grace. Her family story is one that took them from being very engaged Mormons in the LDS church, to realizing that the Gospel they believed for so many years no longer made sense. Unveiling Grace is a book about their journey out of Mormonism and into Biblical Christianity. It also brought aware to some of the initial problems of new families moving in to this area from out of state.

The Week of November 6, 2013

This week Greg interviewed Attorney General John Swallow. They discussed AG Swallow's schooling, background in politics and family. They also discussed the role of the Attorney General and what he does for Utah. Also included in the discussion was issues of the current special house committee investigation of the Attorney General into allegations of alleged ethical misconduct and wrongdoing. A week after this interview John Swallow resigned from his post because of the investigation.

The Week of November 13 & December 18, 2013

This week on What's Up Utah, which airs on Wednesday from 10:30pm to 11:00pm and Fridays from 7:00pm to 7:30pm, and features host Greg Johnson. This week Greg interviewed Most Reverend John C. Wester. They discussed his role as the leading Catholic Bishop for Utah and what his responsibilities, goals, and mission is for the State. They discussed the demographics of the Catholic Church. They also discussed the role of the Pope and the changes that have happened in that position.

The Week of November 20, 2013

This week Greg interviewed Utah Congressman Chris Stewart. They discussed the state of the politics in Utah. They also discussed the fact that Mr. Stewart is an author and wrote a book with Elizabeth Smart. He also talked about his record for flying around the world in the shortest amount of time.

The Week of November 27, 2013

This week Greg interviewed Corinne and Kevin Kligmann. They discussed the program SAFER. SAFER stands for Substance Abuse Family Education and Resources. It is an education program that is offered free to any group of parents in schools, youth groups, scouts etc, and focuses on educating parents on how to recognize and deal with drug use, as well as prevention starting in the home.

They have everything from a 15 minute health fair type of education all the way to a two day seminar, and it is all completely free. The program has even taken the place of the DARE program in some school districts around the country!

The Week of December 4 & 11, 2013

Gary Shatswell from the Adventure Church in Draper was a guest to promote a free, public local music concert that utilized a variety of musical styles.

The Week of November 27, 2013

This week Greg interviewed Utah Congressman Chris Stewart. They discussed the state of the politics and Utah concerns. They also discussed the fact that Mr. Stewart is an author and wrote a book with Elizabeth Smart. He also talked about his record for flying around the world in the shortest amount of time.

KTMW produces and airs a number of live local produced studio productions each week. Each program has open phone line available for viewers to call-in to talk with the host and guests to ask questions or make comments. Among the programs are:

“This Week in the Word” Mondays 11am and repeated at 8pm ...which includes a discussion between various local area Church Ministers dealing subjects of interest to the Christian Community. Among the subjects discussed was a message of hope from Billy Graham...gay marriage...issues of family and marriage problems... During the program, the pastors also discuss verse by verse different bible passages and how it relates to us today. During this past quarter, they are studying chapters 6 – 9 of the book of John and how the teachings affect our daily lives today. They also discuss the weekly activities planned in the local area churches. Phone lines are open for questions and comments from local viewers as people call to ask questions of the pastors.

Wednesdays 8pm the hour long live studio program “Ancient Pathways”, hosted by Jason Wallace, brings in local people for discussions of different issues of concern to Utah people today. They have discussed many issues from racialism to areas dealing with Christianity and Mormonism, living in a Mormon community, same sex marriage & homosexuality. An intense discussion was held about black people...the priesthood.... and Mormonism. Callers are encouraged to call to add to the discussion or voice opposition or ask questions.

Thursdays 8pm Doris Hansen hosts “What Love is This” dealing with people involved in polygamy. Each week the program has people on the program who have been involved in various polygamy communities around Utah. A number of guests appear on her program including many former polygamists who openly described the physical abuse they’ve received while involved in the groups. They also described what led up their departure and escape. Phone lines are open for

viewers to call in questions or comments during the program. Each week there has been a different guest and a different area of concern.

The station has several Utah churches airing their local Sunday Church Services. Sunday programs include: Faith Baptist Church of Layton, 60 minutes; Pastor Myke Crowder of Christian Life Center of Layton 30 minutes; Calvary Chapel of Salt Lake 60 minutes; Calvary Chapel of St. George 30 minutes.

Weekday local church sponsored programs include: Alan Josselyn of The Way Church of Provo a 30 minute weekly interview program dealing the various subject of interest to local community people ; Pastor Ibrahim of Jesus The Way Church of Midvale a 30 minutes weekly topical Bible teaching; Word of the Kingdom sponsored by Miracle Rock Church of Salt Lake City a weekly topical Bible teaching; and 5 nights per week Calvary Chapel of Salt Lake hosts a 30 minute discussion between Pastor Terry Long and Associate John Cowen about local interests and a discussion of the Bible book of John.

KTMW airs daily a 60 minute network program called "Your Health" where Dr. Richard and Cindy Becker discuss important issues concerning health problem and then they open the phone lines for viewers to call-in and ask health questions.

KTMW also airs as a public service a program by Doug Kaufman "Know the Cause" where Doug and his guests discuss vital health issues.

Public Service air time has been given the following PSA announcements from the Ad Council:

5. Feedingamerica.org deals with hunger ...15 second PSA.
6. Letsmove.gov promoting healthy living a 15 second promo.
7. Socialsecurity.gov promotes the Social Security Administration.
8. A message of Hope from Billy Graham (3minute spot 2x week)

These spots each aired a minimum of 3-4 times per day for the 4th quarter 2013.

Additional public service announcements are aired on a regular basis from the Television Networks
