

ISSUES AND PROGRAM LISTS FOR 1st QUARTER 2013

“What’s Up Utah” a weekly half-hour program directed toward the needs and concerns of our Utah Community. The program airs twice per week. This 1st quarter of 2013, the subjects included discussing the need of helping people obtain their GED, a family oriented musical concert for all ages, and teen suicide and bullying.

Also, this quarter, we continued to reach out into our community in discussing the problems and needs of the city of Ogden with Ogden’s mayor.

On a national level, Utah Congressmen Jim Matteson and Mike Lee appeared to discuss how national issues effect people here in Utah.

The Week of January 7th & January 14th, 2013

This week on What’s Up Utah, which airs on Wednesday from 9:30pm to 10:00pm and Fridays from 7:00pm to 7:30pm, features host Greg Johnson and a repeat interview with Eric Juhlin, the CEO of Stevens Henegar college. They discussed what makes Stevens Henegar unique as well as what benefits they offer students. Eric specifically brought attention to their Good Neighbor program that help people earn their GED. They also talked about the 6 million in scholarships that is currently available.

The Week of January 21st, 2013

This week on What’s Up Utah, which airs on Wednesday from 9:30pm to 10:00pm and Fridays from 7:00pm to 7:30pm, features host Greg Johnson and an interview with Ricky Bowersock with Rush Concerts. Ricky was in town to promote the Rock and Worship Roadshow which is a concert with 8 Christian Bands and a speaker that is coming to SLC on February 22nd at the Energy Solutions Arena. They talked about the details of the concert and what makes it a unique family friendly opportunity here in SLC.

The Week of February 4th, 2013

This week on What's Up Utah, which airs on Wednesday from 9:30pm to 10:00pm and Fridays from 7:00pm to 7:30pm, in TV20's effort to reach out into communities of our coverage area, host Greg Johnson brings in a guest interview with Ogden Mayor Mike Caldwell. They discussed the city of Ogden, some of the problem Ogden has faced and corrected such as crime rate, and some of the unique features of the city including ski resorts and a new airline offering flights in and out of Ogden.

The Week of February 11th, 2013 & February 18th, 2013

This week on What's Up Utah, which airs on Wednesday from 9:30pm to 10:00pm and Fridays from 7:00pm to 7:30pm, host Greg Johnson met with Utah 4th District US Congressman Jim Matheson to discuss issues of interest to Utah voters. Among the topics discussed were: the recent voting in the new district boundaries, pro-life and federal funding, protecting Utah's water-resources and canyons, national fiscal responsibility and how it affects local citizens.

The Week of February 25th, 2013 & March 4th, 11th, & 18th, 2013

This week on What's Up Utah, which airs on Wednesday from 9:30pm to 10:00pm and Fridays from 7:00pm to 7:30pm, host Greg Johnson and guest Steve Peterson discussed the crisis of bullying and teen suicides here in the Salt Lake Area.

The discussion centered around an upcoming event that is planned for the Salt Lake Area schools that was initiated by Utah Governor Gary Herbert. An all city wide school assembly on the prevention of bullying and youth suicide is being planned that will be made available to all schools via Interactive Video Conferencing system.

The hour-long assembly will feature Nick Vujicic, a Serbian Australian motivational speaker and evangelist who was born with tetramelia syndrome, a rare condition in which all four limbs are missing. Although Nick was bullied as a youth and considered suicide, he now holds degrees in accounting and

financial planning and is author of “Life Without Limits, Inspiration for a Ridiculously Good Life”

Nick’s presentation is important for Utah students to hear. Bullypolice.org estimates that 22.8 percent of Utah school age children have been bullied. Youth suicide in our state is also of great concern. Utah had the 17th highest suicide rate in the nation from 1999-2010 for youth aged 10-17. While more teen girls attempt to take their own lives in Utah, more teen boys actually die from their attempts.

This hour-long assembly from an internationally known speaker will both engage and inspire Utah students to be more respectful and supportive of each other.

Because of the importance of this event, the program was aired for 4 weeks prior to the event.

The Week of March 25, 2013

This week on What’s Up Utah, which airs on Wednesday from 9:30pm to 10:00pm and Fridays from 7:00pm to 7:30pm, features host Greg Johnson and guest Utah Senator Mike Lee on local and national issues regarding the budget as a moral document. Also on marriage between a man and women.

KTMW produces and airs a number of live local produced studio productions each week. Among the programs are:

“This Week in the Word” Mondays 11am and repeat 8pmwhich includes a discussion between several local area Church Ministers dealing subjects of interest to the Christian Community. Among the subjects discussed this quarter wasbullyingsuicide among teens....church leadership and women in ministry. During the program, the pastors also discuss verse by verse different bible passages and how it relates to us today. During the 1st quarter of this past year, they completed their study of 1st Corinthians . They also open the phone lines for questions and comments from local viewers.

Wednesdays 8pm the hour long live studio program “Ancient Pathways” brings in local people for discussions of different issues. They have discussed issues dealing with Christianity and Mormonism, homosexuality.

Thursdays 8pm “What Love is This” deals with people involved in polygamy. Each week the program has people on the program who have been involved in polygamy. The program has had a number of guests who have been involved with Warren Jeffs church...several young men who have escaped from his control in Colorado City, UT. Phone line are open for viewers to call in questions or comments during the program.
