ISSUE: Governmental Services

PROGRAM TITLE: “In Focus”

AIR DATE/TIME: Broadcast September 10 – 9:30pm;  
September 11 – 1:30 pm;  
September 12 – 7:00 pm

DURATION: Each broadcast is 30 minutes.

SYNOPSIS:

The station hosted a debate among the candidates for Mayor of Salt Lake City: the incumbent Democrat Peter Corroon, Constitution Party candidate Leonard Olds, and Republican Party candidate Michael Renckert. The Mayor said that he had demonstrated fiscal frugality by rejecting a dubious stadium deal and by not raising property taxes, while the others accused him of spendthrift spending. They also discussed public safety and after-school programs.

ISSUE: Single Life

PROGRAM TITLE: “Going Solo in the Second Half of Life”

AIR DATE/TIME: Broadcast August 18 - 8:00 pm

DURATION: 30 minutes

SYNOPSIS:

Author and speaker Samantha Landy taught that being single in the second half of life, despite the death of a spouse or divorce, can still be an exciting and satisfying journey. She stressed that in the wake of a bereavement or divorce, one can still find a full, purposeful life.

ISSUE: Environmentn

PROGRAM TITLE: “Unexplained: Global Warming”

AIR DATE/TIME: Broadcast July14 – 8:00 pm

DURATION: Broadcast was 60 minutes long.

SYNOPSIS:

The program developed assertions that the Earth is currently experiencing the most violent weather in history. Is a doomsday forecast accurate? The program explored solutions to avoid a world-wide catastrophe.

The guest was Doris Hanson, Director of Shield and Refuge Ministry. She described its ministry, function and services, as well as her own past as a child living in a polygamous group. The Ministry provides information and outreach to people living under polygamy. She discussed the ways in which this organization helps individuals and families wishing to escape polygamy.
