ISSUE: Governmental Services

PROGRAM TITLE: “What’s Up, Utah?”

AIR DATE/TIME: Broadcast each week on Wednesdays at 9:30 pm and Fridays at 7:00 pm during the quarter

DURATION: Each broadcast is 30 minutes.

SYNOPSIS:

1. April 4<sup>th</sup> and April 6<sup>th</sup>  
The host of the program interviewed Dan Liljenquist, a candidate for the Senate. He stressed the need for self-reliance as a nation and in communities.
2. April 11<sup>th</sup> and April 13<sup>th</sup>  
The host of the program interviewed Cherilyn Eager, who is running for Congress from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District of Utah. Ms. Eager decried the governmental policies that have led to today’s economic mess.
