This 4 part program presented an in-depth look at the alternatives to pregnancy termination. It featured a panel discussion with experienced crisis pregnancy and post-abortion recovery counselors. The series of programs was designed to offer hope and healing to women (as well as to men) who have been affected by the loss of a child through termination of pregnancy.

AIR DATES/TIME: February 12, 2007 at 8:00 pm

DURATION: Broadcast was 60 minutes long

SYNOPSIS:

The American civil rights movement was examined from the perspective of African-American Churches. Among the churches who participated in the program were congregations from Montgomery; Birmingham and Selma, Alabama, and Atlanta, Georgia. The program was built on interviews of pastors, activists, church members and other participants who recalled the events particular to each church, providing spiritual and historical perspective on their roles in the struggle to end racial inequality in America.
