ISSUE: Governmental Services

PROGRAM TITLE: “What’s Up, Utah?”

AIR DATE/TIME: Broadcast each week on Wednesdays at 9:30 pm and Fridays at 7:00 pm during the quarter

DURATION: Each broadcast is 30 minutes.

SYNOPSIS:

1. January 18th and January 20th
The host of the program interviewed Kevin Fisk, a candidate for the U.S. Senate, who wants to cut wasteful government spending.
2. February 29th and March 2nd
The host of the program interviewed Jay Cobb, a local candidate for the 4th Congressional District of Utah. Mr. Cobb emphasized the importance of private sector job creation and of reducing the national debt.
3. March 7th and March 9th
The host interviewed Dan Liljenquist, a candidate for the U.S. Senate, who stressed the need for a rebalancing of federal-state relations.
4. March 28th and 30th
The host interviewed Stephen Sandstrom, a local candidate for the 4th Congressional District of Utah. Mr. Sandstrom advocated the Second Amendment and opposed identity theft.

1. January 25th and January 27th
The host interviewed Christopher Lindsey and Stephanie Nilsen, the directors of a local school for autistic children. They discussed the challenges faced by autistic children.
2. February 1st and February 3rd
The host interviewed Spencer Slade from the American Lung Association of Utah. Mr. Slade described the organization's programs for youth who suffer from asthma.
3. March 21st and March 23rd
The host interviewed Kerri Luther, a member of the board of "Holding Out Help." She elaborated on the ways in which this organization assists local individuals who leave polygamist relationships.
