



Section 73.3526(e)(12) of FCC Regulations specifically requires licensees to place in their public inspection file for each calendar quarter, a list of programs that have provided the station's most significant treatment of community issues during the preceding three month period.

This quarterly "Issues and Programs List" must include a brief narrative describing what issues were given significant treatment and the programming that provided this treatment. Copies of the issues/programs lists must be retained in the public inspection file until final action has been taken on the station's next license renewal application.
