Ottumwa Police Department is prepping up for a worst case scenario. Ottumwa's Emergency Response Team has added a total of 5 thicker bulletproof vests to their armory. The vests cost \$3,000.00 are designed to stop high caliber bullets. Current Ottumwa Police vests only stop handgun bullets. The new vests will be used in drug raids and threatening situations.

Iowa utilities regulators plan to make a decision on whether to allow a Texas company to bury 346 miles of crude oil pipe under Iowa farmland next month. Iowa Utilities Board chairwoman Geri Huser says the three-member board intends to meet March 9 and consider an order pertaining to the permit application from Texas-based Dakota Access to build the Bakken pipeline. The board must decide whether to allow eminent domain permitting the company to take property from owners of nearly 300 parcels of land who refuse to sign easements. The vote is expected to happen on March 9th or 10th.

**February 24, 2016**

**Time 9:00- 9:30 and 11:00 – 11:30 :48**

The Ottumwa School district has limited their search for Superintendent to four candidates. The candidates selected for interviews were David Schmitt, from West Burlington Community School District, Deron Stender from Virginia Independent School District, in Virginia, Minnesota, Nicole Kooiker, from West Marshall Community School District, and Dr. Lori Simon from Robbinsdale Area Schools, in New Hope, Minnesota. Interviews are scheduled for March 1 to March 4, 2016. The board intends to make their selection by the middle of March, with the new superintendent beginning July 1st. Citizens of Ottumwa are welcome to attend the community/parent interview committee meeting from 4:45pm to 5:45pm on each of the interview dates at the Great Prairie Area Education Agency in Ottumwa.

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources is bringing back a special program to Ottumwa. The DNR will bring its trout stocking program back to Ottumwa Park on March 26th. The fish prefer cold water and the park's ponds are the right temperature for them in the summer. This location has emerged as one of the more popular locations for the program over the past six years. We talked to Gene Rathje Director of the Ottumwa Parks department about the impact of this event on the community.

That's exactly what new legislation in Missouri is aiming to do. The legislation being proposed by state senator Dave Schatz would allow gun owners to avoid having to renew their permit every five years.

Currently... A background check is also done every time a permit is renewed which would no longer happen with a lifetime permit.

Though Schatz says that should not be a problem...

Since the system catches those who commit crimes to revoke their permit though that system is not fool-proof.

City improvement was the topic of discussion at a public meeting with the us department of agriculture this evening. It turns out that because of the size of the city of Ottumwa, the town qualifies for certain financial help from the USDA. That includes low interest loans and grants that can be used to improve the city, including church street which was one of the main topics of discussion at the meeting.

The Ottumwa fire department is putting in some extra work right now, that could help make the area safer. KYOU FOX 15 reporter Jefferson Tyler explains how practice makes perfect, when it comes to saving lives. In this case, the training involves their new 1.2-million-dollar ladder truck. Less than a year old, full of gadgets and gizmos, that extend a ladder more than a hundred feet in the air. We're trying to make it more second nature. Training on equipment like this, allows firefighters to get used to new equipment so when it gets time for them to use it, they know what they're doing. In the middle of the night, or in bad weather. It just becomes second nature and we can put it up quicker.

John Deere today said it was laying off about 100 people from two of its plants in eastern Iowa. About 80 employees have been notified at its factory in Davenport, with another 20 or so coming from its operation in Dubuque. The indefinite layoffs will begin April 1. Both facilities are part of Deere's construction and forestry division

**March 1, 2016**

**Time 9:00- 9:30 and 11:00 – 11:30 1:56**

The Ottumwa city council is meeting tonight to discuss the town's budget for the next year. KYOU FOX 15 reporter Jefferson Tyler brings you details on how your property taxes may be affected. The Ottumwa city council approved the new budget by a unanimous vote tonight. And it will mean an increase in your property taxes.

The debt service levy and the transit levy both went up.

The debt service levy is the debt that piles up for long term capital projects like public works projects like streets, and building infrastructure, like repairing buildings in the area. People say business is like government. Well what a business does is cover its expenses. Well we've covered our expenses.

The transit levy on property tax will go up 10 cents, which will help pay for new services on the city's bus line. The theory there, we hire a new driver, who will pick up new routes, which is something that is needed. Bus fees at this time, however won't go up.

Businesses like that can't exist on fees, so a tax levy funds most of their operations. There have also been some cost decreases. When you look at the employee benefits that was actually lowered over all the total increase, is supposed to go up 20 cents on every 1000 dollars of what your property is worth. Ottumwa Mayor Tom Lazio says it's a necessary increase. Like any resident, I pay local taxes, and I'm not happy taxes are going up. We have to do it to meet our obligations and hopefully we'll be able to lower them in the future. According to figures released in Ottumwa's proposed budget, fire and police make up more than 50 percent of the regular budget, 77 percent of proposed general costs.

The council unanimously approved the Ottumwa Regional Airport apron project. The project will replace and repair much of the cement landing area you can see in this monitor. The idea is to make the runways safer, and allow bigger jets to land, so they can make airport more appealing to bigger planes.

**March 2, 2016**

**Time 9:00- 9:30 and 11:00 – 11:30 2:39**

The Iowa State legislative session is in full swing, governor terry Branstad is hitting up farmers for support of some of his proposed bills, including a proposed bill that could affect you and your children. KYOU FOX 15 reporter Jefferson Tyler has the details.

It's an interesting idea. Governor Terry Branstad is pushing for in Fairfield today. The governor and Iowa Secretary of Agriculture Bill Northy are touring the state, trying to drum up support for a bill that combines funding for education and water quality improvement in the state. Governor Branstad estimates the proposed bill would generate more than 4.7 billion to fix water quality in the state.

Part of the governor's meetings are also about the loans, grants, and programs available to farmers that can help supplement the cost of water conservation. The governor will be in Louisa county, Des Moines county, and lee county tomorrow to continue with these types of meetings.

Governor Branstad and secretary Northy will continue their tour of the state

So Wapello County and Quaker could sign the contract. The deal is a 3-year contract, with a starting salary of 180-thousand dollars.

Your taxes are the focus of discussion at the Wapello County Supervisors meeting tonight. The supervisors have approved their budget for 2016. KYOU FOX 15 News reporter Jefferson Tyler has details on what decisions they have made, and how those decisions will affect your property tax rate.

Its budget time at the Wapello County Supervisors, and they know what people want to hear. Wapello County Supervisor Greg Kenning says there have been cutbacks. The reason for the scrimping and saving...is that a last year's housing re-evaluation may not have the effect you would expect, from the first overall housing re-evaluation since 1978. It could possibly effect the amount of money the county could earn in property tax next year.one of the departments that was affected was the Wapello County Sheriff's Office.

**March 8, 2016**

State Representative Mary Gaskell of Ottumwa, announced today that she will seek re-election to the Iowa House of Representatives in House District 81.

District 81 includes the cities of Ottumwa, Eldon and Agency, seven townships and the part of Center township east of Ottumwa. Rep. Gaskell is currently serving her seventh term in the Iowa House. She serves on the Economic Growth, Local Government, Ways and Means and Administration and Rules Committees. She is also an Assistant Democratic Leader in the Iowa House.

Two presentations made to the council tonight. One of those presentation concerned the hiring of a new part-time parking enforcement officer.

The previous officer left last January. And they have been looking to fill the position. Parking fees pay for many of the services the city provides for the public.

A second presentation concerned an interactive map the city is considering adopting. The map will allow everyday people to access information like zoning laws, and geographic information about the area, that could make it easier to understand if certain city restrictions exist that restrict what you can do to your property. These were both presentations tonight. No votes were taken on the presentations that were given.

The Ottumwa city council is stepping up efforts to get rid of the asbestos in city hall.

The council approved tonight a 28-thousand-dollar contract to r-e-w services tonight to get rid of the chemical insulation.

Last month, asbestos in the basement of city hall was disturbed when construction crews were doing renovation work.

The city council reviewed 2 bids for the product, and r-e-w had the lowest bid, by over 2 thousand dollars. At this time, it's not clear when that work will begin.

ACCORDING TO THE ASSOCIATED PRESS THE Iowa utilities regulators have approved a permit for 346 miles of crude oil pipeline known as THE BAKKEN PIPELINE to be built under Iowa farmland.

Over the objection of thousands of Iowa residents, the Iowa Utilities Board voted unanimously today to let Texas-based company Dakota Access begin the project. The board also will allow Dakota Access the ability to force hundreds of unwilling landowners into easements using eminent domain laws. That is expected to bring

lawsuits. The \$3.78 billion pipeline will carry about a half-million barrels of oil per day from North Dakota to Illinois. Iowa was the only state that had not yet approved a permit for the project, which will stretch across 18 Iowa counties and 1,300 parcels of land.

Deere & Company informed approximately 125 employees at two factories in Iowa that they WOULD be placed on indefinite layoff yesterday. Don't worry Ottumwa isn't included. The workforce adjustment affects approximately 75 employees at Deere's factory in Dubuque and approximately 50 employees at the factory in Ankeny. The layoff at the Ankeny location, which is part of the agriculture and turf division, is effective April 15. The Dubuque facility is included in the company's construction and forestry division and the layoff there is effective April 29. Deere said the company continues to balance the size of its manufacturing workforce with market demand for products at individual factories.

**March 15, 2016**

As Missouri voters hit the polls today, Adair County stepped it up to adjust to an increased turnout this year. The Adair county clerks told us that last presidential primary election the turnout was only 7 percent. This year, they're looking at almost a 35 percent voter turnout. KYOU FOX 15 reporter Jefferson Tyler tells us exactly how they did in coping with such a big increase.

If you're looking for a way to thank the man who turned all the one way streets to two way streets in downtown Ottumwa, the city beat you to it.

The city of Ottumwa named a street after design consultant Christian Rushing who helped in that project. Rushing is also the man who helped get the grant funding for the re-done storefronts down on main street in Ottumwa. He has flown back and forth to Chattanooga Tennessee every month, to get everything done. Rushing way, runs parallel to main street, behind Appanoose Rapids.
