ON AIR INTERVIEWS/PSAs

THE FOLLOWING ARE EVENTS THAT WE WERE ACTIVE IN PROMOTING FROM OCTOBER 1st, 2013 TO DECEMBER 31st, 2013. WE HAVE PROMOTED THESE EVENTS THROUGH PSAS, PROMOS, INTERVIEWS AND/OR LIVE READS

COATS 4 KIDS: The drive began after Labor Day of this year. The deadline is October 14th, 2013 and distribution is October 26th, 2013. This charity is ran by the Salvation Army of Kokomo. It collects winter gear for the less-fortunate of Howard County.

HOWARD COUNTY HEALTH FAIR: This event is scheduled for October 3rd, 2013, but we have promoted this event since September. It's an event that is free to the public and allows them to obtain the necessary vaccinations and screenings.

PINK PANCAKE-PALOOZA: This event is scheduled for October 5th, 2013, but we have promoted this since September. October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, and this event is put on by local hospitals and restaurants. The money raised goes toward battling breast cancer locally.

ROCKERS FOR KNOCKERS: This event is scheduled for October 12, 2013, but we began promoting the event mid-September. October is Breast Cancer Awareness month, and this is an event put on by local musicians to raise money for mammograms at local hospitals.

INDIANA WESLYAN UNIVERSITY/INDEPENDENCE FUND: We began promoting this mid-September and it continues through November 11th. It is a fundraising effort to provide wheelchairs for veterans who need them. The money is collected at Indiana Weslyan locations and through the mail.

INDYSTAR TWITTERTHON: We interviewed Indianapolis Colts punter Pat McAfee November 20th on his Internet fundraiser for people affected by the November 17th tornadoes in Howard County.

UNITED WAY TOY DRIVE: This was an effort that was undertaken by the stations of Hoosier AM/FM, as well as the United Way of Howard County and The Kokomo Herald. We orchestrated a toy drive for the holidays for children affected by the November 17th tornadoes that affected our community. At the end of the drive (December 17th), the toys were given for distribution to The Salvation Army of Kokomo.

LAST ONE STANDING DODGEBALL CHALLENGE: The event is scheduled for January 18th, 2014, but we have been promoting the event since late November. It is a dodgeball tournament that raises money for Bona Vista, which helps those with physical/mental handicaps across Howard and Miami counties, plus other areas as well.

WALK A MILE: The event itself is in Febuary 2014, but our station is running PSAs soliciting donors and volunteers now. The walk is a benefit for a shelter that houses homeless women and children in multiple counties. It is run by the Kokomo Rescue Mission.

POLAR PLUNGE: This is an event that raises money for Area 5 Special Olympics in Indiana (which includes eight counties – including Miami and Howard). It will be held in February of 2014. We have not

yet begun promotion of this (we will do so in November), WMYK and its parent company Hoosier AM/FM are once again media sponsors of this event.
