THE GREATEST SPECTACLE IN TASTING: Held on the grounds of Bona Vista in Kokomo and presented by Soupley's Wine and Spirits and co-Sponsored by Hoosier AM/FM Stations. Wine tasting/food sampling/silent auction to benefit Bona Vista and help those with special needs integrate into the work force. Ran a series of PSAs and Promos and did on air interviews.
