PROGRAM: STATEHOUSE WATCH

7 NEWS AT DAYBREAK

DATES: APRIL 01, 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG COULD FLY AGAIN AT THE STATE HOUSE IN COLUMBIA. THAT IS ACCORDING TO THE STATE NEWSPAPER. THE SOUTH CAROLINA SECESSIONIST PARTY WILL RALLY ON JULY 10TH. THAT IS THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF WHEN THE FLAG CAME DOWN LAST YEAR. SOME LAWMAKERS SAID THEY SAW NO REASON WHY THE SECESSIONIST PARTY SHOULD RAISE THE FLAG AGAIN. IT CAME DOWN AFTER NINE PEOPLE WERE SHOT AND KILLED AT A HISTORIC AFRICAN-AMERICAN CHURCH IN CHARLESTON.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: AFTER A BREAK FROM PRIMARIES WISCONSIN VOTERS HEAD TO THE POLLS TOMORROW. THE LATEST POLL SHOWS A TIGHT RACE FOR BOTH SIDES. THAT POLL ALSO SHOWS BOTH FRONT-RUNNERS TRAILING THEIR COMPETITORS. AT A RALLY YESTERDAY, DONALD TRUMP SAID IT'S TIME FOR JOHN KASICH TO DROP OUT. BUT KASICH SAYS HE'S STAYING IN IT UNTIL SOMEONE CLAIMS THE MAJORITY OF DELEGATES. THE LATEST POLLS SHOW TED CRUZ SIX POINTS AHEAD OF TRUMP. CRUZE MADE SEVERAL STOPS IN WISCONSIN ON SUNDAY INSISTING THAT HE'S THE REPUBLICAN'S BEST SHOT AT WINNING THE WHITE HOUSE. POLLS ALSO SHOW DONALD TRUMP HOLDING STRONG LEADS IN NEW YORK AND PENNSYLVANIA. THOSE STATES WILL HOLD THEIR PRIMARIES AT THE END OF THE MONTH.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: AN UPSATE SENATOR HAS INTRODUCED A BILL SIMILAR TO NORTH CAROLINA'S HB2 BILL. THE BILL, BY STATE SENATOR LEE BRIGHT, WOULD REQUIRE LOCAL BUSINESSES TO DESIGNATE BATHROOMS BASED ON A PERSON'S BIOLOGICAL SEX. "WELL, A LOT OF THESE BIG BUSINESSES HAVE GOTTEN ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE CULTURE WAR, AND I THINK THERE'S GOING TO BE SOME PUSHBACK, AND I THINK THEY'RE GOING TO SEE OVER TIME. I NOTICED PAYPAL GOT HEAVILY INVOLVED IN IT. BUT WE'VE GOT TO DO WHAT'S RIGHT FOR OUR CITIZENS AND I THINK PUBLIC SAFETY IS DEFINITELY IN OUR PURVIEW OF GOVERNMENT," SAYS BRIGHT.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: LAWMAKERS ARE RESPONDING TO AN AUDIT THAT TAKES A CLOSER LOOK AT THE PROBLEM WITH SOUTH CAROLINA'S ROADS. AN OFFICIAL WITH THE LEGISLATIVE AUDIT COUNCIL TALKED TO HOUSE MEMBERS SAYING SOUTH CAROLINA RANKS AT THE BOTTOM NATIONALLY WHEN IT COMES TO PAYING FOR ROADS. THE AUDIT SHOWS MISMANAGEMENT OR FRAUD IS NOT PART OF THE PROBLEM. NEXT WEEK, THE HOUSE IS GOING TO TALK ABOUT THE SENATE'S PLAN TO PUT \$400 MILLION EACH YEAR TOWARD ROADS.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: SOME OF THE CONTROVERSY SURROUNDING THAT NEW TRANSGENDER BATHROOM LAW IN NORTH CAROLINA COULD BE COMING TO SOUTH CAROLINA. SPARTANBURG SENATOR, LEE BRIGHT, HAS INTRODUCED A SIMILAR BILL HERE. IT COMES UP FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON WEDNESDAY AT THE STATE HOUSE IN A SUBCOMMITTEE THAT BRIGHT CHAIRS. THE BILL WOULD BAR CITIES AND COUNTIES FROM PASSING LOCAL LAWS TO ALLOW TRANSGENDER PEOPLE TO USE THE BATHROOMS OF THE GENDER THEY IDENTIFY AS. SENATOR JOEL LOURIE IS ALSO ON THAT SUBCOMMITTEE. HE SAYS HE WILL DO EVERYTHING HE CAN TO BLOCK THE BILL. THE BILL IS ALSO RUNNING OUT OF TIME BECAUSE THERE IS A MAY FIRST CROSSOVER DEADLINE FOR A BILL TO PASS EITHER TO THE HOUSE OR TO THE SENATE.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THERE ARE SIX MORE DAYS BEFORE THE NEW YORK PRIMARY. DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATE, BERNIE SANDERS, VISITED WITH STRIKING VERIZON WORKERS IN NEW YORK, WHILE HILARY CLINTON COURTED THE AFRICAN AMERICAN VOTE AT REVEREN AL SHARPTON'S NATIONAL ACTION NETWORK. CLINTON MAINTAINS A 10 POINT LEAD OVER SANDERS IN THE POLLS. ON THE REPUBLICAN SIDE, DONALD TRUMP, HOLDS AN ALMOST 2-1 ADVANTAGE OVER JOHN KASICH WITH TED CRUZ A DISTANT THIRD.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE SOUTH CAROLINA HOUSE AND SENATE HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO AGREE ON HOW TO FIX ROADS, AND NOW THEY CAN'T AGREE ON WHETHER THE BILL TO DO THAT IS DEAD FOR THE YEAR. STATE SENATORS ARE SAYING THE BILL IS DEAD BECAUSE OF A BIG CHANGE THE HOUSE MADE. THE SENATE PLAN WOULD LET THE GOVERNOR APPOINT COMMISSIONERS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, WITH ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE. THE HOUSE CHANGED THAT SO HOUSE MEMBERS WOULD ALSO HAVE TO APPROVE D.O.T. COMMISSIONERS. SENATORS SAY FORCING NOMINEES TO GET APPROVAL FROM ALL 170 STATE LAWMAKERS WOULD KEEP POLITICIANS IN THE PROCESS OF CHOOSING THE ROADS THAT GET FIXED.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: DONALD TRUMP AND HILLARY CLINTON ARE LOOKING FOR BIG WINS IN TOMORROWS NEW YORK PRIMARY. BERNIE SANDERS IS TRAILING CLINTON BY 10 POINTS IN THE POLLS THERE, BUT HIS STILL HOPING TO UPSET CLINTON IN HER HOME STATE. THIS PRIMARY IS CONSIDERED CRUCIAL FOR BOTH FRONTRUNNERS.

DATES: APRIL 20, 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THERE IS A NEW EFFORD TO REDUCE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN SOUTH CAROLINA. GOVERNOR NIKKI HALEY AND ALMOST ALL OF THE SHERIFFS IN THE STATE ANNOUNCED IT TODAY AT THE STATEHOUSE. THEY ARE ADOPTING POLICIES LIKE; REQUIRING OFFICERS TO FILE POLICE REPORTS ON EVERY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CALL. THAT WILL SHOW IF THERE ARE MORE CALLS THAT ARE ESCALATING OVER TIME. OFFICERS WILL ALSO HAVE A REFERENCE GUIDE FOR HANDLING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. THE SHERIFFS ALSO PLAN TO DO A NEEDS ASSESSMENT, LOOKING AT WHAT THEY HAVE TO HANDLE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, AND WHAT ELSE THEY NEED.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: HUNDREDS OF PEOPLE ON BOTH SIDES OF THE ISSUE ARE EXPECTED TO SHOW UP TO TELL NORTH CAROLINA LAWMAKERS WHAT THEY THINK OF HB2. AN ANTI HB2 GROUP SAYS THEY HAVE COLLECTED A PETITION WITH SIGNATURES ASKING LEGISLATORS TO OVERTURN THE BILL. THEY WILL DELIVER THAT THIS MORNING. PRO HB2 GROUPS SAY THEY WILL START HOLDING PRAYER VIGILS AND A CONCERT AT THE CAPITOL THIS AFTERNOON. A GROUP OF DEMOCRATS IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HAS ALSO ANNOUNCED THEY WILL BE FILING A REPEAL TO HB2 THIS MORNING. THEY WILL HAVE A NEWS CONFERENCE AT 11.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: LAWMAKERS ARE TRYING TO WORK OUT A FINAL PLAN TO FIX SOUTH CAROLINA'S ROADS AND BRIDGES. ONE OF THE LAWMAKERS SAYS HE WILL PUSH FOR A GAS TAX INCREASE. HOUSE DEMOCRATIC LEADER, TODD RUTHERFORD, CRITICIZED REPUBLICANS TODAY FOR NOT PASSING A GAS TAX INCREASE BECAUSE IT'S AN ELECTION YEAR. HE SAYS A GAS TAX INCREASE IS A USER FEE FOR PEOPLE WHO DRIVE, AND NOT PASSING ONE WILL COST MORE. SENATE TRANSPORTATION CHAIRMAN LARRY GROOMS SAYS THERE WAS NO NEED TO PASS A GAS TAX INCREASE BECAUSE THE STATE HAS A \$1.4 BILLION SURPLUS. A CONFERENCE COMMITTEE OF THREE HOUSE MEMBERS AND THREE SENATORS MET TODAY TO START WORKING ON A FINAL ROADS BILL.

DATES: MAY 2, 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES ARE MAKING A FINAL CAMPAIGN PUSH IN INDIANA, WHICH HOLDS ITS CRITICAL PRIMARY TOMORROW. 92 DELEGATES ARE AT STAKE FOR DEMOCRATS, 57 ARE ON THE LINE FOR REPUBLICANS. REPUBLICAN FRONT-RUNNER, DONALD TRUMP, STILL PAINTS HIMSELF AS THE EVENTUAL GOP NOMINEE. HE MOCKED HIS RIVALS' CHANCE AT A CAMPAIGN EVENT IN INDIANA LAST NIGHT. TRUMP LEADS BY 15 POINTS IN THE POLLS IN INDIANA. ON THE DEMOCRATIC SIDE, HILLARY CLINTON AND BERNIE SANDERS ARE SEPARATED BY JUST A FEW POINTS IN THE POLLS. CLINTON STILL HAS A LEAD IN THE DELEGATE COUNT.

DATES: MAY 4, 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: REPUBLICAN TED CRUZ IS SUSPENDING HIS RUN FOR THE GOP NOMINATION FOR PRESIDENT. HE LOST THE INDIANA PRIMARY TO DONALD TRUMP. TRUMP IS NOW THE PARTY'S "PRESUMPTIVE" NOMINEE. JOHN KASICH SUSPENDED HIS CAMPAIGN ON MAY 3. A NEW POLL SHOWS HILLARY CLINTON WITH A 13 POINT LEAD OVER TRUMP IN A HEAD-TO-HEAD CONTEST. BERNIE SANDERS WON THE INDIANA PRIMARY AND SAYS HE HAS NO PLANS TO QUIT.

DATES: MAY 6, 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE CLOCKS ARE TICKING AS NORTH CAROLINA LAWMAKERS FACE A DEADLINE TO CHANGE ITS CONTROVERSIAL HB2 LAW. THE REQUEST CAME EARLIER THIS WEEK AFTER A WARNING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE. IN A LETTER TO GOVERNOR PAT MCCRORY, THE STATE WAS ACCUSED OF VIOLATING BOTH THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT AND TITLE NINE OF THE EDUCATION AMENDMENTS UNDER ITS HB2 LAW. THE MEASURE PROHIBITS LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FROM PASSING LEGISLATION REQUIRING TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS PERMISSION TO USE THE PUBLIC RESTROOM OF THEIR CHOICE. DESPITE THE DEADLINE, MANY NORTH CAROLINA LAWMAKERS REFUSE TO BACK DOWN. SOME DEMOCRATIC LAWMAKERS FILED BILLS TO REPEAL THE LAW, BUT HAVEN'T HAD SUCCESS.

DATES: MAY, 10 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: CBS NEWS PROJECTS BERNIE SANDERS HAS WON THE WEST VIRGINIA DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY, DEFEATING HILLARY CLINTON. SANDERS WAS IN CALIFORNIA TODAY, LOOKING AHEAD TO THE PRIMARY THERE, WHICH IS ON JUNE 7TH. A NEW POLL OF SWING STATES SHOWS CLINTON, AND PRESUMPTIVE REPUBLICAN NOMINEE, DONALD TRUMP, IN A VIRTUAL TIE. CLINTON SPENT THE WEEK IN KENTUCKY AHEAD OF NEXT WEEKS PRIMARY THERE. TRUMP RAN UNOPPOSED TODAY, TAKING PRIMARY WINS IN WEST VIRGINIA AND NEBRASKA.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A BILL THAT IS SUPPOSED TO MAKE SCHOOL BUSES SAFER IN SOUTH CAROLINA LIKELY WON'T PASS THROUGH THE LEGISLATURE THIS YEAR, BUT SUPPORTERS HOPE THEY HAVE A HEAD START WHEN LAWMAKERS RETURN TO WORK IN JANUARY. A SENATE SUBCOMMITTEE PASSED THE BILL STRENGTHENING A LAW AGAINST PASSING A STOPPED SCHOOL BUS. THE STATE WOULD BE ABLE TO MAIL A TICKET TO THE REGISTERED OWNER OF THE CAR THAT BREAKS THE LAW. RIGHT NOW, THE DRIVER HAS TO BE CLEARLY IDENTIFIABLE IN VIDEO OR A PICTURE.

DATES: MAY, 26 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: STATE LAWMAKERS GOT A NEW REPORT TODAY ON THE PROBLEMS AT THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE. STATE INSPECTOR GENERAL, PATRICK MALEY, HAS BEEN INVESTIGATING D.J.J. SINCE MARCH. THERE WERE THREE RIOTS IN D.J.J. FACILITIES FROM SEPTEMBER TO FEBRUARY. MALEY TOLD A JOINT COMMITTEE OF SENATORS AND HOUSE MEMBERS THAT SEVERAL THINGS LED TO THE PROBLEMS. ONE IS A LACK OF CONSEQUENCES FOR KIDS WHO CAUSE TROUBLE, AND GUARDS ARE WORKING 12-HOUR SHIFTS WITH INADEQUATE TRAINING. HE SAYS D.J.J. IS TAKING STEPS TO CORRECT THE PROBLEMS. LAWMAKERS HAVE PUT MONEY IN NEXT YEAR'S BUDGET TO GIVE EVERY D.J.J. OFFICER A \$1,500 RAISE.

DATES: MAY, 26 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: WITH JUST TWO WEEKS GO TO BEFORE YOU CAST YOUR VOTE FOR THE NEXT GREENVILLE COUNTY SHERIFF, CANDIDATES HAD THE CHANCE TO GIVE THEIR TWO CENTS ON HOW THEY THINK THEY CAN MAKE GREENVILLE COUNTY A BETTER PLACE. EACH OF THE FIVE CANDIDATES SPOKE ABOUT IMPROVING RESPONSE TIMES WITHIN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND HOW THEY CAN USE SOCIAL MEDIA TO TRACK CRIME MORE EFFECTIVELY. THEY ALSO COMMENTED ON WAYS TO IMPROVE COMMUNICATION AMONG OTHER DEPARTMENTS IN THE COUNTY. THE NEXT FORUM WILL TAKE PLACE ON JUNE 7TH AT 6PM AT THE HUGHES MAIN LIBRARY.

DATES: JUNE 2, 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: TODAY IS THE LAST DAY OF THE LEGISLATIVE SESSION FOR STATE LAWMAKERS IN SOUTH CAROLINA. THEY ACCOMPLISH WHAT THEY ALL AGREED WAS THE BIGGEST ISSUE IN THE STATE, FIXING ROADS AND BRIDGES. THEY PASSED A PLAN YESTERDAY THAT WILL PUT MORE THAN \$4 BILLION DOLLARS INTO ROADS AND BRIDGES OVER THE NEXT TEN YEARS. BUT SOME LAWMAKERS SAY THAT IS ALSO ONE OF THE BIGGEST THINGS THEY DID NOT DO, BECAUSE THERE NO STEADY SOURCE OF NEW MONEY FOR ROADS. THEY PUT MORE MONEY INTO SCHOOLS, INCLUDING A TWO-PERCENT PAY RAISE FOR TEACHERS, AND MONEY FOR SOME NEW BUSES. BUT THEY DID NOT PASS A PLAN TO ADDRESS THE STATE SUPREME COURTS RULING THAT THE STATE DOES NOT PROVIDE AN ADEQUATE EDUCATION IN RURAL SCHOOLS.
