PROGRAM: STATEHOUSE WATCH

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 7PM

DATES: APRIL 1, 2014

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE READ TO SUCCEED ACT WOULD HOLD STUDENTS IN SOUTH CAROLINA BACK IF THEY'RE NOT READING AT GRADE LEVEL AT THE END OF THIRD GRADE. THEY WOULD GET INTENSIVE READING HELP TO CATCH UP. THE SENATE DEBATED THE BILL TODAY BUT DIDN'T TAKE A VOTE. THERE'S CONCERN ABOUT THE POTENTIAL COST TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF HOLDING BACK SO MANY STUDENTS. THIRTY ONE OTHER STATES HAVE SIMILAR LAWS. STUDIES SHOW A STUDENT NOT READING AT GRADE LEVEL AFTER THIRD GRADE IS SIX TIMES MORE LIKELY TO DROP OUT OF HIGH SCHOOL.

DATES: APRIL 2, 2014

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A BILL ALLOWING PEOPLE SUFFERING FROM SEVERE SEIZURES TO USE OIL FROM MARIJUANA, IS CLOSER TO BECOMING LAW IN SOUTH CAROLINA. THE HOUSE PASSED THE MEASURE ON APRIL 2ND. IT ALLOWS DOCTORS TO USE CANNABIS OIL TO TREAT EPILEPSY. THE SENATE PASSED A SIMILAR VERSION OF THE BILL LAST WEEK. DOCTORS IN COLORADO ARE CURRENTLY USING IT IN MEDICAL TRIALS.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT NOON

DATES: APRIL 3, 2014

PROGRAM SUMMARY: IT'S BEEN 18 MONTHS SINCE SOMEONE HACKED SOUTH CAROLINA'S DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE. SINCE THEN, WE'VE DISCOVERED THE STATE STILL DOES NOT HAVE A CONSISTENT PLAN FOR PROTECTING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION. STATE SENATORS SAY THEY WERE SRUPRISED BY THE NEWS. GOVERNOR NIKKI HLAEY SIGNED AN EXECUTIVE ORDER LAST YEAR REQUIRING HER CABINET AGENCIES TO FOLLOW A COMPUTER SECURITY PLAN. BUT, SHE COULD NOT REQUIRE AGENCIES THAT ARE NOT PART OF HER CABINET TO DO IT. THE PLAN INCLUDED AROUND THE CLOCK MONITORING OF STATE AGENCY COMPUTERS TO WATCH FOR SIGNS OF HACKING. LAWMAKERS SAY THEY PLAN TO TAKE ACTION.

DATES: APRIL 04, 2014

PROGRAM SUMMARY: TODAY, MOTHERS AGAINST DRUNK DRIVING APPLAUDED THE HOUSE FOR GIVING FINAL APPROVAL TO EMMA'S LAW. THE MESURE MAKES FIRST OFFENDERS WITH A BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVEL OF .15 OR GREATER INSTALL AN INGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE ON THEIR VEHICLE. FOR NOW, ONLY REPEAT OFFENDERS HAVE IGNITION INTERLOCKS. THE LAW IS NAMED FOR A SIX YEAR OLD KILLED BY A DRUNK DRIVER IN 2012.

DATES: APRIL 05, 2014

PROGRAM SUMMARY: ANOTHER HEARING IS PLANNED IN AN ETHICS CASE AGAINST SOUTH CAROLINA SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE BOBBY HARRELL. WE WERE THERE WHEN A JUDGE HEARD ARGUMENTS ABOUT REMOVING STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL ALAN WILSON FROM THE CASE. HARRELL SAYS WILSON HAS A CONFLICT OF INTEREST. LAWYERS ARE GETTING MORE TIME IN THE CASE. A STATE GRAND JURY IS CONSIDERING WHETHER HARRELL SHOULD BE INDICTED. HE IS ACCUSED OF USING HIS OFFICE FOR FINANCIAL GAIN.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 5PM

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A BILL NOW IN THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE SENATE WOULD RAISE SOME FEES AND PUT THAT MONEY TOWARD ROADS. THAT INCLUDES INDEXING THE GAS TAX TO INFLATION. BUT NOW THERE'S CONCERN THAT WOULD BE RULED OUT OF ORDEER, AND MIGHT NOT HAVE TIME TO GET THROUGH THE STATEHOUSE. THE BILL WOULD TAKE \$41 MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE SALES TAX ON CARS AND USE THAT MONEY FOR ROADS. RIGHT NOW THAT MONEY GOES INTO THE GENERAL FUND. SENATORS COULD STILL ADD SOME FEE INCREASES TO THE BILL, SUCH AS RAISING THE DRIVER'S LICENSE FEE, OR REGISTRATION FEE TO BRING MORE MONEY FOR ROADS. GOVERNOR NIKKI HALEY SAYS SHE WILL VETO ANY TAX OR FEE INCREASE. THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION NEEDS \$1.5 BILLION DOLLARS A YEAR TO BRING ROADS AND BRIDGES UP TO GOOD CONDITION.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 11PM

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A BILL TO MAKE IT ILLEGAL FOR COLLEGES TO USE LOTTERY MONEY ON BUILDINGS AND MAINTENANCE IS ON ITS WAY TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA HOUSE FLOOR. THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE PASSED THE BILL. RIGHT NOW IT IS LEGAL FOR COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES TO USE LOTTERY MONEY FOR THINGS SUCH AS REPAIRING AN AIR CONDITIONER OR HELPING BUILD A NEW BUILDING. THIS BILL WOULD SPELL OUT IN LAW THAT LOTTERY MONEY COULD NOT BE USED FOR THAT. IN THE LAST TWO YEARS, MORE THAN \$37 MILLION IN LOTTERY MONEY WENT TO BUILDINGS, MAINTENANCE, AND TRAINING.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE SENATE JUST VOTED TO AGREE TO THE HOUSE'S AMENDMENTS GIVING FINAL APPROVAL OF "EMMA'S LAW." THE BILL WOULD REQUIRE ALCOHOL BREATH TESTING DEVICES BE INSTALLED INTO THE VEHICLES OF FIRST-TIME DRUNK DRIVER OFFENDERS. THE MORE OFFENSES, THE LONGER THE DEVICE HAS TO STAY INSTALLED. IT HAS TAKEN THE BILL TWO YEARS TO REACH THE GOVERNOR'S DESK. SOUTH CAROLINA WILL BECOME THE 36TH STATE TO PASS THIS TYPE OF LAW.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 11PM

PROGRAM SUMMARY: LAWMAKERS GAVE FINAL APPROVAL TO A BILL THIS WEEK ENDING A THREE-DECADE OLD REQUIREMENT THAT HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MUST PASS AN "EXIT" EXAM TO GRADUATE. SINCE 1986 STUDENTS HAVE TAKEN AN EXIT EXAM. RIGHT NOW, SOPHOMORES ARE GIVEN WHAT'S CALLED THE H-SAP, OR HIGH SCHOOL ASSESSMENT PROGRAM. THEY HAVE TO PASS IT TO GET THEIR DIPLOMA. UNDER THE NEW LEGISLATION, STUDENTS WOULD INSTEAD TAKE A COMBINATION OF A JOB SKILLS ASSESSMENT, COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS EVALUATION.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 11PM

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A NEW WEBSITE CALLED FIXSCROADS.COM IS ASKING DRIVERS ACROSS THE STATE TO LET LAWMAKERS KNOW WHAT'S WRONG WITH THE ROAD SYSTEM. THE WEBSITE WAS CREATED BY THE SOUTH CAROLINA ALLIANCE TO FIX OUR RAODS. THE GROUP WILL SHARE WHAT YOU SAY ON THE SIET WITH STATE LAWMAKERS. YOU CAN POST PICTURES OF THE POTHOLES YOU SEE. THE GROUP SAYS IT HOPES YOU WILL ALSO CONTACT YOUR LAWMAKER DIRECTLY. ACCORDING TO THE ALLIANCE, ROAD CONDITIONS PLAYED A ROLE IN ONE OUT OF EVERY THREE FATAL WRECKS IN 2013. 47% OF THE STATE'S PAVEMENT CONDITION IS CONSIDERED "POOR." ONLY 15% IS CONSIDERED GOOD.

DATES: **APRIL 14, 2014**

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A NEW DRUNKEN DRIVING LAW IS ON THE BOOKS IN SOUTH CAROLINA. TODAY, GOVERNOR NIKKI HALEY SIGNED "EMMA'S LAW." IT REQUIRED ANYONE WITH A FIRST CONVICTION FOR DUI WITH A BLOOD-ALCOHOL LEVEL OF .15 OR GREATER TO GET AN IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE FOR SIX MONTHS. THE LOCK WOULD GO IN PLACE FOR TWO YEARS FOR A SECOND CONVICTION WITH A BLOOD-ALCOHOL LEVEL OF .08, THE STATE'S LEGAL LIMIT.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 11PM

DATES: **APRIL 16, 2014**

PROGRAM SUMMARY: LAWMAKERS IN SOUTH CAROLINA ARE WORKING ON A BILL TO HELP PUT VETERANS BACK TO WORK. THE BILL ALLOWS EMPLOYERS TO GIVE HIRING PREFERENCE TO VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF DISABLED VETS. IT IS NOW IN THE FULL SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE. A SPOKESWOMAN FOR THE STATE RETAIL ASSOCIATION SAYS EMPLOYERS WANT TO HIRE VETS, BUT DO NOT WANT TO BE LIABLE FOR GIVING THEM PREFERENCE. THE HOUSE UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED THE BILL LAST MONTH.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 7PM

DATES: **APRIL 17, 2014**

PROGRAM SUMMARY: SOUTH CAROLINA COULD START USING ALTERNATIVE FUEL SCHOOL BUSES. WSPA CONFIRMED THE SENATE FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE APPROVED A PROGRAM IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR NEW SCHOOL BUSES, IF SCHOOL DISTRICTS ARE WILLING TO PAY PART OF THE BILL. THE ALTERNATIVE-FUEL SCHOOL BUSES ARE EXPECTED TO COST \$10,000 MORE THAN THE REGULAR BUSES.

DATES: **APRIL 18, 2014**

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A BILL IN THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATEHOUSE AIMS TO REEL IN A BIG INDUSTRY. THE BILL WAS INTRODUCED IN THE SENATE, AND REDFINES BREW PUBS AS OPERATIONS THAT PRODUCE UP TO 500,000 BARRELS OF BEER A YEAR, INSTEAD OF THE CURRENT WORDING WITH A LIMIT OF 2,000.

DATES: **APRIL 20, 2014**

PROGRAM SUMMARY: IT COULD SOON COST MORE TO KEEP YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION SECURE. LAWMAKERS IN SOUTH CAROLINA ARE CONSIDERING A PLAN THAT WOULD REQUIRE AGENCIES TO ADOPT CYBER-SECURITY STANDARDS. IT WOULD COST THE STATE ABOUT \$27 MILLION. THE PLAN COMES AFTER A DATA-BREACH BACK IN 2012, WHEN UNENCRYPTED DATA WAS STOLEN FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE. SIX MILLION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES WERE IMPACTED. THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD SAYS STATE LAW DOESN'T ALLOW THEM TO MAKE POLICIES MANDATORY. A CLAUSE IN THE HOUSE BUDGET PLAN GIVES THEM THAT AUTHORITY. THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE PUT A SIMILAR CLAUSE IN ITS BUDGET PLAN.

DATES: **APRIL 21, 2014**

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A NEW JOBS REPORT FROM THE NORTH CAROLINA STATE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT SHOWS MORE PEOPLE ENTERED THE JOB MARKET LAST MONTH THAN IN MOST OF THE PAST YEAR. THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN NORTH CAROLINA WORKING OR LOOKING FOR WORK GREW BY ALMOST 8,000 IN MARCH. THAT DROPPED THE STATE'S JOBLESS RATE TO 6.3%. A FEDERAL REPORT SAYS NORTH CAROLINA TRAILED ONLY FLORIDA FOR LARGEST MONTHLY EMPLOYMENT GROWTH.

PROGRAM: **GREER TEXTING BAN**
DATES: **APRIL 22, 2014**

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 11PM

PROGRAM SUMMARY: GREER CITY COUNCIL GAVE FINAL APPROVAL TO A NEW LAW ON TEXTING AND DRIVING. COUNCIL VOTED 5-2 IN FAVOR OF THE ORDINANCE AFTER A TWEAK TO ALLOW VOICE TO TEXT TECHNOLOGY. STATE LAWMAKERS ARE CONSIDERING A UNIFORM STATE-WIDE LAW.

DATES: **APRIL 23, 2014**

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT DAYBREAK

PROGRAM SUMMARY: EARLY VOTING IN NORTH CAROLINA GETS UNDERWAY IN LESS THAN 48 HOURS. THE RULES FOR VOTING HAVE CHANGED. LAWMAKERS APPROVED CHANGED TO ELECTIONS, BRINGING A NEW SET OF CHALLENGES TO LOCAL OFFICIALS. ON-STOP EARLY VOTING HAS BEEN CUT FROM 17 DAYS DOWN TO TEN. DURING THAT TIME ELIGIBLE VOTERS CAN REGISTER AND CAST A BALLOT ON THE SAME DAY, BUT NOT ANYMORE. THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER FOR THIS PRIMARY WAS APRIL 11TH.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT DAYBREAK

PROGRAM SUMMARY: GUNS ARE ALLOWED IN MORE PLACES IN GEORGIA. GOVERNOR NATHAN DEAL SIGNED A LAW ALLOWING CONCEALED WEAPONS TO BE CARRIED IN BARS, CHURCHES, AND GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS WITH NO SECURITY SCREENINGS. ALSO, LICENSED OWNERS CAN NOW CARRY GUNS INTO ANY PART OF GEORGIA MUNICIPAL AIRPORTS THAT ARE NOT BEHIND SECURITY CHECKPOINTS. YOU HAVE TO BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD WITH NO DRUG OR WEAPON FELONY CONVICTIONS AND NO MENTAL HEALTH HOSPITALIZATION WITHIN THE PAST FIVE YEARS. THIS NEW LAW TAKES EFFECT JULY 1ST.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT 11PM

PROGRAM SUMMARY: FORMER GOP CANDIDATE FOR GOVERNOR TOM ERVIN SAYS HE WON'T STOP CALLING HIMSELF A REPUBLICAN. THE STATE PARTY IS THREATENING TO SUE IF HE DOESN'T STOP RUNNING AN AD WHERE HE USES THE TITLE "INDEPENDENT REPUBLICAN." ERVIN DROPPED OUT OF THE REPUBLICAN PRIMARY. HE SAID HE DIDN'T HAVE TIME TO MOUNT A CAMPAIGN AGAINST GOVERNOR NIKKI HALEY. INSTEAD HE'S RUNNING AS A PETITION CANDIDATE ON THE NOVEMBER BALLOT. HE'LL BE RUNNING AGAINST HALEY AND DEMOCRATIC STATE SENATOR VINCENT SHEHEEN.

7 ON YOUR SIDE AT DAYBREAK

PROGRAM SUMMARY: A SOUTH CAROLINA BILL GIVING EMPLOYERS THE RIGHT TO SHOW PREFERENCE TO VETERANS MOVES ONE STEP CLOSER TO PASSAGE. THE LEGISLATION IS POPULAR IN THE HOUSE AND WILL HAVE A SECOND READING IN THE SENATE TODAY. THE BILL IS THE FIRST STEP TO PUT OUR 23,000 UNEMPLOYED VETERANS BACK TO WORK IN SOUTH CAROLINA. THE PALMETTO STATE RANKS 6TH IN THE NATION FOR UNEMPLOYED VETERANS. THE BILL WANTS TO CHANGE THAT BY CONNECTING UNEMPLOYED MILITARY MEMBERS WITH CIVILIAN EMPLOYERS. THERE HAVE BEEN GROUPS THAT HAVE EXPRESSED CONCERN. A BIG VOICE IS THE SOUTH CAROLINA RETAIL ASSOCIATION. THE GROUP WAS WORRIED THAT SHOWING A PREFERENCE COULD OPEN THEM UP TO LAWSUITS. NOW THE RETAIL ASSOCIATION SAYS IT IS NO LONGER WORRIED.

DATES: MAY 05, 2014

PROGRAM SUMMARY: ONE CANDIDATE FOR SUPERINTENDENT OF SOUTH CAROLINA SCHOOLS WANTS POT TO BE LEGALIZED. DEMOCRAT SHEILA GALLAGHER SAYS TAXING MARIJUANA COULD HELP FUND EDUCATION.
