

WYBE-CD Certification of Continued Eligibility for Licensing as a CLASS A Television Station, October, November, December, 2016. Multimedia Network of North Carolina, Inc., the licensee for WYBE-CD certifies that it complies with those station operating requirements set forth in subparts H and J of 47 C.F.R. Part 73 that are applicable to Class A stations. WYBE-CD continues to broadcast 24 hours per day as it has since it first began broadcasting on the air. WYBE-CD airs over three hours of locally originated programs per weekday as well as locally originated programs on both Saturday and Sunday, all of which are produced by the station with original content. This clearly meets the FCC requirements of “three hours.” Among the locally produced programs airing during this quarter: Mark! My Words (half-hour episodes, airing M-F, 7:00 a.m., 7:30 a.m., 5:00 p.m., and 5:30 p.m.) Also airing were Mark! My Words on Books and Mark! My Words on Music segments, Town Talk (half-hour episodes, airing daily, 11:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.) Moore Minutes (three to five minute segments air four to five times daily.) Moore Animals (three to four minute segments air five to six times daily.) WYBE-CD has filed all required Children’s Program reports with the FCC. The children’s programs produced or aired by WYBE-CD all meet requirements for restrictions on commercials aired during children’s programs. WYBE-CD maintains a public file in accordance with FCC requirements, available at the station’s primary facility and to be posted on line. Multimedia Network of North Carolina, Inc., the licensee for WYBE-CD certified its continued compliance with Class A requirements in its application for renewal of license in 2012.
