




Mitten News LLC has identified the follow community issues in its service area:

- 1) Severe Weather Information
- 2) Elder Issues
- 3) Natural Gas Emergency in Michigan

Mitten News programs and public service that addressed the above issues:

- 1) WJML continues local news coverage at the top of every hour Monday-Friday 24-hours a day. We are the only local radio station providing news and information both day and night!
- 2) WJML broadcast severe storm information live 24-hours a day. Power outages, school closings, road and county closures, etc. This winter we had on average 11 missed school days due to weather in January and February. A state of emergency was declared over one 3-day period from the governor.
- 3) WJML ran a series of recorded PSA's on the need to reduce natural gas usage for a period of 48-hours as the state dealt with a fire at a major gas hub.
- 4) WJML Continues to support the community with the Saturday 9am program that features local charities, not for profits and other groups seeking airtime for those they assist. This January we aired and interviewed people affected by and working with Dementia patients and their families.
- 5) The Steve Gruber Show, Monday – Friday 6-9am addresses issues affecting the state and provides Northern Michigan with a voice and way to connect to state office holders.
