Third Quarter

Issue: Finding purpose in Tragedy

July 5 Carried Family Talk at 9:30 for 30 minutes. They interviewed Joni Erickson Tada about her accident that left her paralyzed and how she worked through the ordeal

Issue: Anger

July 9, 10 We broadcast a two part program on Focus on the Family with guest, Ted Cunningham about how to deal with Anger and the fallout of problems anger produces in a family.

Issue: College Culture

July 25 With classes about to pick up for fall semester, Family Life Today interviewed Hanna Seymour about the culture on today's campuses and how parents can better prepare their children to be equipped to handle the various pressures and risks.

Issue: Internet Safety

August 7 We aired the thirty minute program Family Life Today at 8:30 as they interviewed Brian Housman about internet safety from viruses, as well as predatory scams and stalking.

Issue: Surviving Infidelity

August 21 We carried the Focus on the Family program at 8:30 for 30 minutes. They interviewed Gary and Mona Shriver with information about how to survive infidelity in a marriage and rebuild the trust and relationship.

Issue: End of Life Preparation

August 28 We broadcast Focus on the Family at 8:30 for thirty minutes about how to prepare for our final years of living. How to put our affairs in order and get a will.

Issue: Sexual Exploitation

September 3 Broadcast Family Talk at 9:30 for 30 minutes. Dr. Dobson spoke with Patrick Trueman, president, and CEO of The National Center on Sexual Exploitation, to discuss the damage pornography is creating in peoples' hearts and minds.

Issue: Troubled Teens

September 4 On Focus on the Family at 8:00 for thirty minutes, they interviewed Dr. Kevin Leman on how parents can support a child and keep the family together, even when the child is rebellious and creating difficulty in the home and community.

Issue: Same sex attraction

September 5 On our Family Talk broadcast at 9:30, Dr. Dobson spoke with licensed marriage and family therapist, David Pickup about those who feel trapped or overwhelmed by same-sex attraction and options that are available to them to find freedom. He explained Re-integrative Therapy and confronted the claims against this treatment. He also identified the source of those feelings and how to address each one.

September 12 On Family Life Today at 8:30 for thirty minutes, we carried an interview with D.A. and Elicia Horton about indebtedness and how to develop a financial plan towards a financial path of freedom.
