Story: Crime Victims Week

Date: 4/2-9/17 7am, 8am, 5pm, 9pm

Synopsis: WHEN A CRIME VICTIM TESTIFIES AGAINST THE ASSAILANT, SHOULD THEY WORRY ABOUT RETALIATION? VICTIM ADVOCATES WANT TO REVERSE STATE LAWS MAKING IT HARDER FOR VICTIM INFORMATION TO LAND IN THE WRONG HANDS. THE MAN WHO SHOT ROOSEVELT WARD IS SERVING - 2- THIRTY FIVE YEAR SENTENCES. ON TOP OF HIS LIFE CHANGING INJURIES, SHOULD THIS CRIME VICTIM FEAR RETALIATION FOR TESTIFYING AGAINST THE SHOOTER? TO REMOVE ANY CHANCE THE COURTS WOULD AID THAT RETALIATION, ST. Date: 4/7/17 4am, 6am, 7am, 8am, 9am, 11am

Synopsis: WE CAN SHOW YOU SOME VIDEO FROM WHERE THE SHOOTING HAPPENED. THE VIOLENCE UNFOLDED ON KAH-SUTH NEAR GRAND POLICE GETTING THE CALL JUST AFTER MIDNIGHT. WHEN POLICE ARRIVED AT THE SCENE, THEY FOUND ONE MAN SHOT. HE WAS RUSHED TO A HOSPITAL WHERE HE WAS PRONOUNCED DEAD. WE SAW 30 EVIDENCE MARKERS AT THE SCENE THAT TYPICALLY INDICATE SHELL CASINGS DISCOVERED BY POLICE. POLICE TELL ME THE MAN WHO WAS SHOT AND KILLED WAS THE ONLY PERSON HIT BY BULLETS. HOMICIDE DETECTIVES HAS BEEN CALLED IN TO INVESTIGATE THE CASE. SO FAR, POLICE HAVE NO SUSPECTS THERE WAS A CONVERTIBLE AND A TRUCK INSIDE THE CRIME SCENE TAPE. Synopsis: ALL OF THIS COMES AFTER TWO FATAL SHOOTINGS AND TWO RECENT SUSPICIOUS PACKAGES BELIEVED TO BE BOMBS THAT TURNED OUT TO BE A HOAX....ST. LOUIS COUNTY POLICE STILL ASKING FOR THE PUBLIC'S HELP IN IDENTIFYING THAT SUSPECT OR SUSPECTS FROM THE BRENTWOOD STATION OVER THE WEEKEND. MONDAY METRO RELEASED A STATEMENT SAYING... 'METRO IS NOW POSTING AVAILABLE PUBLIC SAFETY DATA IN RESPONSE TO REQUESTS FOR THE INFORMATION. Synopsis: AT LEAST 30 DETECTIVES WITH THE GREATER ST. LOUIS MAJOR CASE SQUAD ARE ON THE GROUND HERE INVESTIGATING THE CASE. THE CRIME SCENE HERE LITTERED WITH EVIDENCE OF THE DEADLY SHOOTING THAT HAS LEFT THREE MEN DEAD AND NEIGHBORS CONCERNED. WE CAN SHOW YOU VIDEO AS BOMMARITO AUTOMOTIVE SKY FLEW OVER THE ACTIVE SCENE. THE DEADLY SHOOTING HAPPENED AROUND 10 A.M. AS SOON AS THEY RELEASED SURVEILLANCE IMAGES BROCK SCHMITTLER AND HIS FRIEND KARL GENTHON BLASTED THE INFORMATION ALL OVER THE CLOSED GROUP PAGE.

Synopsis: LAKE ST LOUIS POLICE HAVE VIDEO OF A ROBBERY AT THE VICTORIA SECRETS AT THE MEADOWS THEY WANT YOU TO SEE. Synopsis: WITH THE RECENT NUMBER OF HOMICIDES IN ST., LOUIS CITY COMMUNITY LEADERS ARE WORKING TOGETHER TO STOP THE VIOLENCE. SATURDAY MORNING HUNDREDS ATTENDED A CRIME PREVENTION SUMMIT AT THE OFALLON PARK RECREATION CENTER IN NORTH ST. LOUIS. PARTICIPANTS ARE HOPING TO PROVIDE A PRODUCTIVE FORUM FOR DISCUSSING STRATEGIES TO PREVENT VIOLENT CRIMES AND IMPROVE SAFETY FOR AREA RESIDENTS. AUTHORITIES TELL US THE STORE WHERE AS HIT ABOUT TWO THIRTY ON MONDAY MORNING. POLICE SAY THE THIEVES BROKE THE FRONT DOOR GLASS, AND THEN STOLE RIFLES AND HANDGUNS. WE'RE TOLD TWO TOYOTA CAMRY'S MIGHT HAVE BEEN USED. IN A STATEMENT, FORD ENCOURAGED OWNERS OF THE SIX-POINT-TWO LITER MODELS TO ALWAYS USE THEIR PARKING BREAK AS A SAFETY PRECAUTION. FORD SAYS SO FAR IT HAS NOT RECEIVED ANY REPORTS OF INJURIES OR ACCIDENTS BECAUSE OF THE DEFECT. THE FIX WILL BE FREE.

Story: Garbage Disposal Recall

Synopsis: ANAHEIM MANUFACTURING AND MOEN ARE RECALLING ABOUT 146-THOUSAND GARBAGE DISPOSALS BECAUSE METAL PARTS INSIDE COULD FLY OFF DURING USE.

THE CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION SAYS 22 CUSTOMERS HAVE REPORTED METAL COMPONENTS FLYING OUT OF DISPOSALS. THREE PEOPLE WERE HIT BY METAL -- BUT NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. THE DISPOSALS WERE SOLD IN RETAIL STORES AND ONLINE FROM DECEMBER 2015 AND MARCH 2017. IF YOU HAVE A RECALLED MODEL...CALL THE MANUFACTURER FOR A FREE REPLACEMENT.
