All job openings are listed on our web site, advertised on our airwaves, also in the New York State Broadcasters Association Job Bank and are also delivered to the attached list of diversity resources.

#1. Internship Program:

An ongoing internship program provides training and opportunities to learn each aspect of the broadcasting field. During the applicable period, one (1) non paid/college credit only interns participated in this program. The Radio station disseminated information on this program to all area Colleges, and through the SUNY system. We received (6) responses to the internship request, interviewed (4) interns for interest, and qualifications and granted one internships, during 2016. A general internship agenda and program was established for the participants, and at the completion of the program a certificate of completion was awarded to each intern.

#2. New York State Broadcasters Association - Nelson Rockefeller Internships

WGNY/WJGK participated in the NYSBA Internship program in 2016. During the applicable period, 1 paid internships were awarded to Full-time college students. The Radio station disseminated information on this program to all area Colleges, and through the SUNY system. A general internship agenda and program was established for the students, and at the completion of the program a certificate of completion was awarded.

#3. Job Fairs:

Participation in Local EXPOS/Career Events- WGNY/WJGK personnel throughout the report period attended and participated in various events including the Orange County Community College and the Mount St. Mary Colleges Career Days.

#4. Tours:

WGNY personnel throughout the report period promoted and conducted various events, both inside the radio station consisting of tours to area students and their parents, to educate and disseminate information regarding employment.
