### Narrative Description of Program/Segment

Live telephone interview with Dr. Elizabeth Ford, foster parenting resource expert with Focus on the Family. We discussed what was required to be a foster parent and how to apply for a license. We also discussed the special requirements in the State of Missouri. Dr. Ford also shared with us the psychological responsibilities that come with foster parenting, pointing out that many of these children have been abused or abandoned. She pointed out that building trust and creating a safe home atmosphere were two of the most important this a foster parent could do.
