WTVN provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Auto safety and care: Rich White, Executive Director of the Ohio Car Care Council, discussed the importance of getting a vehicle inspected to ensure road safety and savings. He talked about how a tune-up can help an engine deliver the best of balance and power, along with fuel economy and produce the lowest level of emissions. We posted the Council's car safety tips on the WTVN Communities Web page.
- Childhood obesity: Staff members from the Ohio Department of Health talked about childhood obesity. They said when it comes to that subject the first step is awareness. They also stated the health agency researched that 76 percent of mothers don't know their child is overweight and many are not taking simple steps to improve their children's weight status. We posted Ohio Department of Health child nutrition information on the WTVN Communities Web page.
- **College planning:** Administrators from the Ohio Department of Education talked about how college graduates are twice as likely to be employed as those with no college degree and can expect to earn about 66 percent more. They discussed how to get college hopefuls connected to experts with advice on useful college-planning strategies.
- Heart health event: Dr. Anne Albers, cardiologist with Ohio Health Heart and Vascular Physicians, discussed the latest heart disease and stroke research news from the American Heart Association. She also talked about the upcoming American Heart Walk. Ohio Health was the presenting sponsor of the walk.
- Homeownership and investment value: Laura Ellis of the Ohio Board of Realtors discussed how citizens still believe in the value of homeownership, even with the ups and downs of the housing market. She

stated that three-quarters of adults polled in a recent statewide survey said they believe owning a home is the best long-term investment they can make, better than retirement savings or stock market investments.

- Internet safety: Local Internet safety experts discussed keeping your personal information safe and how clicking on bad links can expose you to a variety of Internet dangers such as scammers, hackers and malware. We posted Internet safety tips on the WTVN Communities Web page.
- School sports safety for girls: Local school administrators talked about how teen girls tend to be more active than they used to be. They said two-thirds participate in a school sport, the most popular being cheerleading. They noted that more girls are also active in field hockey, soccer and basketball.
