WTVN provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Asthma and allergies:** Representatives from the American Lung Association talked about improving the understanding of asthma, allergic asthma and some available testing options.
- **Auto safety:** Members of the Car Care Council talked about how thousands of cars every year that are damaged in floods end up back on the road. They offered information on getting vehicle history reports.
- **Blood pressure screening and donation:** Eric Johnson of the American Red Cross Blood Services Division talked about the high number of people with high blood pressure and how they are unaware of their condition. He said he sees many situations where prospective blood donors are deferred because of high blood pressure found during screening. He offered information to help raise awareness of the condition.
- **Bone health/Calcium deficiency:** Representatives from the American Dairy Association discussed a USDA report they says nine out of ten women and seven out of ten men fail to meet the recommended two to three servings a day of calcium and more than half of all children don't get enough. They gave information to help stop the trend toward calcium deficiency.
- **Child safety before and after school:** In the wake of a recent fatal accident involving a child hit by a car while walking to her school bus stop, local school officials discussed ways to reduce these incidents with simple safety tips for parents to discuss with their children.
- **Community involvement:** Area schoolchildren talked about their holiday volunteer work during the winter school break and the importance of community service while in school.
- **Diabetes: Genetics and Prevention:** This special edition produced by iHeartRadio and hosted by Shelli Sonstein, took a closer look at what it means to live with diabetes, the risk factors of prediabetes and the role genetics play in preventing and understanding the disease better.
- **Managing personal finances:** Local financial expert Terrance Williams talked about how a growing number of people are finding that keeping their checking and savings accounts at the same bank is costing them

money. He discussed how an intranet bank can be a viable alternative.
