WTVN provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Black History Month events:** Staff and volunteers from the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Arts Complex talked about the family activities going on during Black History Month at the center.
- **Childhood cancer support:** Courtney Bollen, Director of Community Development for Curcsearch, talked about families of children with cancer that often face many expenses health insurance doesn't cover. She said the organization is committed to improving the quality of life for children with cancer. We posted information about their programs and services on the Clear Channel Communities Web page.
- **Domestic violence victim support:** Staff from the Ohio Coalition on Domestic Violence talked about how people are reluctant to discuss the subject with a friend or family member, even though domestic violence affects one in four women. They said the organization is working with other community agencies to educate citizens and bring attention to the issue.
- **Educational tools for low-income students:** Officials from the Central Ohio Kids In Need Foundation discussed the year-round need to have school supplies collected for teachers who work in low-income schools. They offered information to listeners about the free tools needed for kids to succeed in school. We posted the details on the Clear Channel Communities web page.
- **Emergency preparedness:** Local American Red Cross CEO Matt Bertram talked about community efforts in fire prevention and emergency preparedness. He also discussed volunteering for the American Red Cross

and the need for more blood donors.

- **Radio service for the visually impaired:** Sandy Turner, Executive Director of VOICBCorps, a community radio reading service for the visually impaired, discussed the year round programs, services and volunteer opportunities. The radio service's volunteers read newspaper and magazine articles, obituaries, advertisements and comic strips for its listeners.
- **Retired veteran assistance:** Officials from the Department of Veterans Affairs discussed retired veterans and how they may qualify for monetary relief available through the Administration's Aid and Attendance Benefit. They said that qualifying veterans and their families may be eligible for this pension for serving their country during a declared war. They offered information on upcoming education seminars and getting access to veteran service providers.
