- **Public safety:** Central Ohio law enforcement officers discussed efforts to make New Year's Eve celebrations safe, and also talked about safety initiatives.
- **Child health:** Dr. Sam Torres, a board member for the Central Ohio Breathing Association, discussed respiratory diseases in children.
