Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WTVN provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **2015 Year-End Wrap-Up:** Highlights of this year's discussions on education, housing, race relations/diversity, hunger, veterans and family health.
- **Autism/children:** Representatives from Autism Speaks discussed how they are working to improve the lives of children with autism. They said that the earlier in life children with autism receive services, the more hope they have for their futures.
- **Company investment in employees:** Douglas Younger of the Ohio Employee Assessment Resources Commission talked about how many Ohio companies are making it their business to invest in their employees. He said a great number of them are establishing wellness programs and other benefits.
- **Flu vaccinations:** Representatives from Ohio Health talked about flu prevention and the importance of getting a flu shot. We posted their information on our iHeartMedia Communities page. We also partnered with Ohio Health and the Kroger Company in providing free flu shots for our listeners.
- **Fraud protection:** Representatives from the U.S. Postal Inspection Service were guests and offered details about how con artists spend time and energy creating scams. They also gave a lot of insight on how to help protect yourself and your family from fraud.
- **Human trafficking:** Staff members from the Salvation Army of Central Ohio talked about recognizing a few signs that may enable to help identify children who are victims of human trafficking. Among the signs they discussed are children who may seem controlled, isolated, fearful and nervous and avoid eye contact. We posted their helpful information on the iHeartMedia Communities page.
- **Hunger:** Columbus Community Profile Christmas Show: Matt Habash, Executive Director of Mid-Ohio Food Bank, talked about the various partnerships and collaborations with area businesses to ensure wide distribution of food to the hungry in the community.

- **Internet safety/Privacy settings:** Local Internet expert Kevin Scott discussed the many network users who have never changed their default privacy settings. He also said that a larger number of people he surveyed are unsure who can see their profile online. He offered online safety tips and we posted them on the iHeartMedia Communities page.
- **Military & Veterans (Impact of injuries on family):** Representatives from the Veterans Crisis Line talked about the returning soldiers who are affected by post-traumatic stress or traumatic brain injuries. They discussed how their spouses and children are being profoundly impacted. They gave information about how the Veterans Crisis Line connects them with various programs and services that give help and hope.
