Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WTVN provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Auto safety:** Staff members from the Ohio Car Care Council talked about how under-inflated tires are a major cause of blowouts during warmer months and the importance of checking your tire pressure. They stressed checking tires for uneven wear, high or low areas or unusually smooth sections. We posted their tire safety information on the WTVN Communities Web page.
- **Child hunger prevention:** Charlie Kozlesky, Senior Vice President of School and Summer Nutrition with Children's Hunger Alliance, talked about the 2014 Ohio Summer Food Service Program which sets up fun, educational and recreational feeding sites for children during the summer months. He talked about their partnership with the Ohio Department of Education, which administers the program.
- **Dental health:** Dr. Richard Lee, a neuromuscular dentist with the Ohio Dental Health Association, talked about how neuromuscular dentists can help people suffering from migraines and other pains. He said such problems as facial pain, neck, shoulder and back pain, teeth grinding, breathing problems and sleep disorders, can be treated by using computer analysis.
- **Environment:** Amy Holloway of the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of Ohio discussed indoor pollution being a leading cause of health problems. She went through a list of ways to control allergens and we posted them on the WTVN Communities Web page.
- **Eye health:** Staff members from the Ohio Optometric Association talked about how the food you eat can protect your eyes and reduce your risk of long-term vision problems. We posted a link to their online information on the WTVN Communities Web page to help them promote eye health.
- **Family health:** Valerie Jones of the Ohio Department of Health talked about dehydration, and how people may be unaware of the condition even while they may be dehydrated themselves. She said dehydration is the number-one cause of stress in the body and is preventable. We posted a link to the online information and posted it on the WTVN Communities Web page.
- **Heart health:** Joanna Gregory of the American Heart Association of Central Ohio discussed how heart disease is affecting one out of every three people. She talked about their partnership with Time To Talk Cardio, which is an educational program offering free resources to help manage heart health.
- **Housing concerns for seniors:** Barbara Aldridge of AARP talked about how it's important for loved ones to be content with their home. She said to match housing to changing needs, it helps to understand the options. She discussed

age-restricted communities, assisted living arrangements providing personal care and support services, nursing homes and continuing-care retirement communities, where she said services vary with residents' requirements.

- **Hunger:** A specially-produced program that focused on hunger and featured country music artists who came together to use their talent to create awareness of the hunger problem. The artists also recorded a tune called "Give 'Em Hope" in which 100% of the proceeds will go to community food banks all over America.
- **Mental health care for military:** Jessica Nelms of the Ohio Department of Veteran Affairs discussed the high number of returning soldiers affected by post-traumatic stress or traumatic brain injuries. She said their spouses and children are being profoundly impacted by this medical and mental health crisis.
- **Podiatric health:** Dr. Jeffrey Moore of the Ohio Podiatric Medical Association discussed information to keep your feet in good shape and avoid problems in the warm weather months.
- **Privacy protection:** Jason Blackshear, Community Director for the U.S. Postal Service Central Ohio Region, talked about maintaining control of your privacy and the security of personal information. He discussed in detail the benefits of using Post Office Boxes.
- **Saving energy:** Staff members from the Central Ohio Energy Council offered some simple steps to take to make your home more green. They said that a green home uses less water and energy than the average home, recycles more waste and avoids the use of toxic cleaning agents and lawn and garden chemicals.
