- **Arthritis management:** Susan Davis, Executive Director for the Arthritis Foundation of Central Ohio, discussed a program that encourages manufacturers to design and offer user-friendly products and packaging. She said that day-to-day tasks can get done with less stress on joints.
- **Caregiver support:** Staff members from the Central Ohio Area Agency on Aging discussed caregivers and offered information on recognizing limits. They said when other offered help, take it and suggest specific things they can do. They said that it is especially important when caring for others to care for yourself, too. We posted resources for caregivers on the WTVN Communities page.
