WTVN provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- | **Auto safety:** Staff from the Central Ohio Auto Safety Council discussed keeping your car well-maintained and how carpooling can help cut fuel use and help the country towards being independent. They talked about numerous energy-saving methods and we posted them on the Clear Channel Communities Web page.
- | **Car insurance information:** Cynthia Pullman of the Ohio Auto Insurance Institute discussed how talking to an insurance agent can make a big difference when shopping for car insurance. She offered information on how agents who sell policies from more than one company can offer you more options because they have more companies and insurance products to choose from.
- | **Celebrity sports gala:** Paul Huttlin, CEO and Executive Director of Recreation Unlimited, talked about the fundraising event called the "Celebrity Sports Gala." He said it will fund summer camp programs for the developmentally challenged. Huttlin is a member of the Clear Channel Media + Entertainment - Columbus Local Advisory Board (LAB).
- | **Child and adult cancer support:** Staff from the American Cancer Society talked about the 80 percent of children and adolescents who are diagnosed with cancer and become long-term survivors. They also said that recent medical research has found that adult survivors of childhood cancer face higher risks for chronic health conditions. We posted information on the WTVN Communities Web page to help listeners learn about the physical and mental effects of childhood cancer and tips on healthy living.
- | **Childhood hunger prevention:** Charlie Kozlesky, Senior Vice President of School and Summer Nutrition for Children's Hunger Alliance, talked about the 2013 Ohio Summer Food Service Program, which sets up feeding and activities sites for kids during the summer months.
- | **Eye health:** Staff from Prevent Blindness Ohio talked about how harmful UV rays that can damage your eyes are actually present year-round. They gave information on visiting your doctors regularly for health checkups, including your eye doctor for a comprehensive eye exam.
- | **Gambling dangers:** Staff from the Ohio Council On Problem Gambling talked about how a preoccupation with gambling may cause some people to risk more than money. They said people may be gambling away their health, happiness and their family's welfare. They discussed the risk factors and we posted them on the WTVN Communities Web page.
- | **Healthcare employment opportunities:** Staff from the Columbus Career Resource Center talked about healthcare and how it continues to represent the largest employment sector in the U.S. economy. They said this is due in part to the

aging population. They also said that many job openings in Central Ohio will also result from the need to replace experienced nurses who leave the occupation. WTVN was the media sponsor for their job fair which also included employers from many other fields.

- | **Military and veterans:** Jeff Hamilton of the Ohio Department of Veteran Affairs discussed Operation Peer Support, which connects combat-blinded veterans of World War II, Korea and Vietnam with blinded veterans of Iraq and Afghanistan.
- | **Military and wounded warriors:** A special report on the wounded warriors and their families who use the Fisher House, a home-away-from-home for wounded military soldiers and their families while they recover from their injuries.
