Dear Ms. Goldin:

This is in response to your EEO audit letter dated April 24, 2023, regarding the EEO program for the subject Station licensed to ION Television License, LLC ("Licensee"). The Station is licensed as a full power satellite station that rebroadcasts 100% of the programming of its parent station, WEPX-TV, Greenville, North Carolina, and the two stations together constitute a single employment unit.

The Station employs fewer than five full-time employees. The Station's full-time employees, identified only by job title, and the number of hours regularly assigned to work per week are:

Manager, Station Broadcasting	40 hours/wk.
Station Technician	40 hours/wk.

In response to your Question 2(b)(vi), there are no pending or resolved complaints involving the Station filed during the Station's current license term before any governing body having competent jurisdiction under federal, state, territorial, or local law, alleging unlawful discrimination in the employment practices of the Station based on race, color, religion, national, origin or sex. Finally, the Licensee is not the broker of another station within its market and WPXU-TV is not a brokered station.
