5:30P NEWS: ACTION NINE: Four days per week, 2:00 in length. Consumer reporter acts as an advocate for consumers who are not getting satisfaction from businesses or government. Tries to help them solve their own problems or encourage the two parties to work out a solution.

FAMILY FOCUS: One report, two minutes in length, and each week focusing on family and children issues. Reports are part of WSOC-TV's station community campaign: Family Focus, which includes PSA's, events, programs, community projects. Also repeats on Saturday mornings.

TRAFFIC REPORTS: Nine times daily during **EYEWITNESS NEWS DAYBREAK** and once each during 7:25 AM and 8:25 AM breaks. Includes alternate route information. Also, half hour in midday if there is breaking traffic news. Traffic Reports air every 9 mins from 7a-9a on TV64.

Life After Death: The Rae Carruth Story: Friday, October 19th from 9p-10p. As former Carolina Panther Rae Carruth is set to be released from prison for his role in the shooting death of his pregnant girlfriend, WSOC-TV takes an in-depth look at the 1999 crime and what has happened since in the lives of those involved. Interviews include police detectives who investigated the crime, a juror on the case, Carruth's lead attorney, and Saundra Adams -- the grandmother raising Carruth's son, who survived the shooting but lives with severe disabilities. Eyewitness News anchor Erica Bryant hosts this program, with special reporting by Mark Becker and Glenn Counts.

District 9 Investigation: Thursday, December 6th from 7p-8p. The Eyewitness News team is breaking every development in the growing election fraud investigation in the race for NC's 9th District Congressional Seat. With Political Reporter Joe Bruno leading the way, the team is uncovering suspicious absentee ballots, illegal ballot gathering and votes that weren't counted. The special report includes exclusive investigative reporting and analysis as a seat in the U.S. House of Representatives hangs in the balance.

Priced Out of Charlotte: Friday, December 7th from 8p-9p. In a special presentation from Eyewitness News, we are investigating the problem and looking for solutions for the thousands of people being priced out of Charlotte.

THEY ALSO APPROVED THREE TAX INCENTIVES FOR A PROJECT ONLY KNOWN AS "PROJECT ALPHA 3" IN STANLEY. IT'S AN ADVANCED MANUFACTURING OPERATION THAT COULD HIRE 20 PEOPLE.

NEW OVERSIGHT FOR MECKLENBURG CO. HEALTH DEPT. IN DOUBT

FUTURE GOVERNANCE CHANGES FOR THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT ARE IN DOUBT.

OUTGOING COMMISSIONER JIM PUCKETT SAYS THE LAME DUCK BOARD WILL NOT CONSIDER ANY NEW

OVERSIGHT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH. IN MAY, WE REPORTED COMMISSIONERS VOTED 6-2 TO FORM A COMMITTEE TO

EXPLORE CHANGING WHO GOVERNS THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT. CURRENTLY COUNTY MANAGER DENA DIORIO

OVERSEES THE DEPARTMENT. POTENTIAL CHANGES INCLUDED AN ADVISORY BOARD, PRIVATIZING THE

DEPARTMENT AND A SEPARATE BOARD OF HEALTH. DESPITE VOTING TO FORM THE COMMISSIONER LED

COMMITTEE IN MAY, THE COMMITTEE NEVER MET BECAUSE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER'S LEAVE OF ABSENCE.

FEMA REJECTS APPEAL TO DECLARE N.C. COUNTIES DISASTER AREAS

FOR THE SECOND TIME, FEMA REJECTED AN APPEAL TO DECLARE POLK COUNTY-- AND 10 OTHER NORTH CAROLINA COUNTIES-- DISASTER AREAS. THE COUNTIES WERE LOOKING FOR HELP AFTER MUDSLIDES IN MAY. POLK COUNTY LEADERS WERE LOOKING FOR \$80,000 TO COVER OVERTIME HOURS WORKED DURING RESCUES AND CLEANUP. SOME RESIDENTS ARE CONFUSED AS TO WHY FEMA WOULD REJECT THE STATE'S APPEAL. AN APPLICATION FOR HELP WILL NOW GO TO THE STATE. IF THE STATE DEEMS THE AREA A DISASTER AREA, MONEY COULD COME. BUT, NOT NEARLY AS MUCH AS COUNTY OFFICIALS HAD HOPED.

WAKE CO. LEADERS RELEASE BID FOR AMAZON'S HQ2

AMAZON IS BUILDING ITS SECOND HEADQUARTERS IN NEW YORK AND VIRGINIA. BUT TODAY, WE GOT OUR HANDS ON WAKE COUNTY'S BID TO TRY AND SWAY THE ONLINE GIANT. COUNTY LEADERS WERE WILLING TO GIVE AMAZON A \$106M-\$277M TAX BREAK TO COME TO THE COUNTY... DEPENDING ON WHERE IT WANTED TO BUILD. THE COUNTY SAID IT WAS WILLING TO GO ABOVE AND BEYOND BECAUSE IT WOULD HAVE SEEN \$15B OVER 15 YEARS.

UNION COUNTY LEADERS TO OFFER INCENTIVES FOR MORE JOBS

UNION COUNTY IS OFFERING \$1.3M IN INCENTIVES TO CONVINCE A GLOBAL COMPANY TO EXPAND IN MONROE. LAST NIGHT, MONROE CITY COUNCIL AND UNION COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVED GRANT PACKAGES-- FOR UNITED TECHNOLOGIES AEROSPACE SYSTEMS. THE COMPANY IS CONSIDERING A \$26M INVESTMENT AT ITS MONROE FACILITY. LEADERS SAY THE POTENTIAL TAX REVENUE WILL FAR EXCEED THE HUGE OFFER. UNION COUNTY LEADERS HOPE THE COMPANY WILL DECIDE BY THE END OF THE YEAR. THE INCENTIVES WOULD BE PAID OVER FIVE YEARS, BASED ON HOW WELL THE COMPANY DOES.

IREDELL CO. LEADERS CONSIDER INCENTIVES FOR EXPANSION

LEADERS FROM THE CITY OF MOORESVILLE AND IREDELL COUNTY-- ARE CONSIDERING MORE THAN \$700,000 IN TAX INCENTIVES TO HELP A COMPANY EXPAND. THE UNNAMED COMPANY IS ALREADY CONSIDERING A \$17M INVESTMENT AT ITS LOCAL FACILITY. THEY WANT TO BUILD A 293,000 SQUARE-FOOT BUILDING — AND BUY NEW MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT. MOORESVILLE COMMISSIONERS AND IREDELL COUNTY LEADERS WILL VOTE ON THE TAX BREAKS NEXT WEEK.

CHANNEL 9 INVESTIGATES EXCESSIVE CITY SPENDING IN MONROE

UNNECESSARY HOTEL STAYS AND EXCESSIVE MEAL COSTS ON A CITY CREDIT CARD. CHANNEL NINE INVESTIGATED HUNDREDS OF PAGES OF EXPENSE REPORTS BY MONROE CITY LEADERS. TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS ATTENDED A CONFERENCE IN CHARLOTTE LAST YEAR AND STAYED IN UPTOWN HOTELS; RATHER THAN COMMUTE FROM MONROE. ONE OF THE BILLS WAS MORE THAN \$1,000! LAST MONTH, THE SAME TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS, SURLATA ANTHONY AND FRANCO MCGEE, WENT TO L.A. FOR THE SAME CONFERENCE. ANTHONY'S TRIP COST \$2,800. BUT MCGEE'S WAS MORE THAN \$4,000, PARTLY BECAUSE HIS MOTHER WENT, TOO. MCGEE PUT HER FLIGHT AND MEALS ON THE CITY CREDIT CARD.

IREDELL CO. LEADERS STUDY COST OF REMOVING PCE FROM LIBRARY

THIS WEEK, IREDELL COUNTY LEADERS WILL LEARN HOW MUCH IT WILL COST TO REMOVE A POTENTIALLY CANCER-CAUSING CHEMICAL FROM THE STATESVILLE LIBRARY! WE FIRST TOLD YOU IN APRIL, THE COUNTY DISCOVERED PCE WAS CONTAMINATING THE LIBRARY. THEY BELIEVE IT MAY HAVE LEAKED DECADES AGO FROM A NEARBY LAUNDROMAT. THE LEVELS ARE BELOW THE STATE STANDARDS FOR ADULTS. OUR PARTNERS AT THE STATESVILLE RECORD AND LANDMARK REPORT -- BLOCKING THE PCE VAPORS COULD COST \$250,000 OR MORE. COMMISSIONERS WILL DISCUSS THIS ISSUE AT THEIR MEETING TUESDAY.

IMPACT OF POTENTIAL FEDERAL SHUTDOWN COULD BE WIDESPREAD

WE'RE NOW JUST DAYS AWAY FROM A PARTIAL GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN. THE GOOD NEWS... ABOUT 75% OF THE GOVERNMENT WOULD 'NOT' BE IMPACTED IF THIS HAPPENS. PRESIDENT TRUMP HAS REFUSED TO SIGN ANY SPENDING BILL THAT DOESN'T INCLUDE MONEY FOR HIS BORDER WALL. HE'S SAID HE'D BE HAPPY TO SHUT DOWN THE GOVERNMENT IN THE NAME OF BORDER SECURITY. BUT THE WHITE HOUSE PRESS SECRETARY SAID TODAY THERE ARE 'OTHER WAYS' TO GET THE FUNDING. PART OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WILL LOSE FUNDING ON FRIDAY. AND THE IMPACT OF A SHUT DOWN -- WOULD BE WIDESPREAD. MORE THAN 420,000 PEOPLE WOULD BE WORKING WITHOUT PAY! THAT INCLUDES 41,000 FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AND CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS AND UP TO 88% OF DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY EMPLOYEES. 53,000 TSA EMPLOYEES WOULDN'T BE PAID--RIGHT AT THE PEAK OF HOLIDAY TRAVEL! THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE TRYING TO GET A LOAN OR REFINANCE THROUGH THE FEDERAL HOUSING ADMINISTRATION MORTGAGE WOULD BE PUT ON STANDBY. SOME OF OUR MOST VULNERABLE AMERICANS COULD RUN INTO PUBLIC HOUSING PROBLEMS. PAYMENTS TO THREE-THOUSAND PUBLIC HOUSING AGENCIES WOULD BE DELAYED. IT WOULD PUT EMERGENCY REPAIRS ON HOLD AND FAMILIES ON WAITLISTS FOR PUBLIC HOUSING ... WOULD HAVE TO WAIT EVEN LONGER. THE FDA WOULD ALSO CLOSE. THAT MEANS THOSE ROUTINE, UNANNOUNCED INSPECTIONS WOULD BE PAUSED. AGAIN-- ALL OF THIS - IF- NOTHING CHANGES BEFORE FRIDAY.

REPORT: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CAUSED MORE S.C. KILLINGS

A NEW REPORT SAYS SOUTH CAROLINA IS ONE OF THE DEADLIEST STATES FOR WOMEN.... AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PLAYS A BIG ROLE. THE VIOLENCE POLICY CENTER JUST RELEASED A REPORT RANKING THE STATE SIXTH FOR THE PERCENTAGE OF WOMEN KILLED BY MEN. THE CENTER CITED HOMICIDE DATA FROM 2016 -- SHOWING 48 WOMEN IN SOUTH CAROLINA WERE MURDERED BY MEN THAT YEAR. IT SAID 95% OF THE VICTIMS KNEW THEIR KILLERS. NORTH CAROLINA TIED FOR 17TH ON THE LIST.

COMMUNITY MOURNS AFTER S.C. OFFICER SHOT & KILLED

LOVE IS STRONGER THAN HATE. THAT FROM THE PASTOR OF FALLEN FLORENCE POLICE SERGEANT TERRENCE CARRAWAY. THE COMMUNITY GATHERED TO GRIEVE AND LEAN ON EACH OTHER THE NIGHT AFTER INVESTIGATORS SAY A MAN OPENED FIRE - KILLING ON OFFICER - AND WOUNDING SIX OTHERS. IT LOOKED LIKE EVERY SEAT WAS FILLED TONIGHT AT FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH IN FLORENCE. MEMBERS OF THE BILLY GRAHAM EVANGELISTIC ASSOCIATION IN CHARLOTTE WERE THERE TO READ SCRIPTURE. BUT PERHAPS THE MOST MOVING SPEAKER WAS THE PASTOR OF SERGEANT CARRAWAY'S HOME CHURCH IN DARLINGTON. HE TALKED ABOUT HOW CARRAWAY DEMONSTRATED SO MUCH LOVE - AND ENCOURAGED EVERYONE TO TAKE A PIECE OF THAT LOVE -BACK TO THEIR COMMUNITY. SERGEANT CARRAWAY WILL BE HONORED BY THE CITY OF FLORENCE WITH A PUBLIC VIEWING MONDAY. TWO WOUNDED CITY OFFICERS HAVE BEEN RELEASED FORM THE HOSPITAL. A THIRD OFFICER WAS LISTED IN SERIOUS BUT STABLE CONDITION. THERE'S BEEN NO WORD ON THE CONDITIONS OF THE THREE WOUNDED SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES. WE'RE ALSO LEARNING MORE ABOUT THE SUSPECT, FREDERICK HOPKINS. HE LOST HIS LAW LICENSE IN THE 1980'S OVER \$18,000 IN WRONGFULLY COLLECTED ATTORNEY FEES. COURT DOCUMENTS SHOW IN 1984 - HE WAS ALLOWED TO PAY BACK THE DEBT AND SURRENDER HIS LICENSE RATHER THAN SERVE A 6-MONTH JAIL TERM. ACCORDING TO FACEBOOK POSTS FROM HOPKINS - HE STARTED SHOOTING COMPETITIVELY AROUND THE SAME TIME HE WAS DISBARRED. COURT RECORDS ALSO SHOW HE WAS INJURED IN VIETNAM AND RECEIVED DISABILITY PAYMENTS.

WADESBORO MAN CHARGED WITH MURDER

A WADESBORO MAN IS BEHIND BARS THIS MORNING, CHARGED WITH MURDER. WADESBORO POLICE ARRESTED "SHAQUILLE POLK." INVESTIGATORS SAY POLK SHOT AND KILLED "TYWAN STURDIVANT" LAST FRIDAY. CHANNEL NINE SPOKE TO NEIGHBORS FRIDAY WHO SAID THEY HEARD AROUND A DOZEN GUNSHOTS AROUND 3:30 IN THE MORNING AND RUSHED TO HELP STURDIVANT.

COMMUNITY SERVICES PLANNED FOR SLAIN N.C. TROOPER

TODAY, FRIENDS, FAMILY, AND THE LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMUNITY WILL HONOR A FALLEN NORTH CAROLINA STATE TROOPER. MEMORIAL SERVICES ARE PLANNED IN TABOR CITY, NORTH CAROLINA FOR TROOPER KEVIN CONNER. CONNER STOPPED A PICKUP TRUCK WEDNESDAY. TROOPERS SAY WHEN HE APPROACHED THE PULLED-OVER CAR, RAHEEM DAVIS SHOT HIM. DAVIS IS CHARGED WITH FIRST-DEGREE MURDER.

STUDENTS RETURN TO CLASS AFTER DEADLY SHOOTING

THIS IS EXPECTED TO BE A DAY UNLIKE ANY OTHER AT BUTLER HIGH SCHOOL. TODAY, THE STUDENTS ARE RETURNING TO CLASS, BUT THEY ARE ALSO RETURNING TO THE SCENE OF A CRIME. SECURITY WILL BE TIGHT WITH MATTHEWS POLICE AT EVERY SCHOOL IN TOWN AND THE CHIEF WILL SPEND THE DAY AT BUTLER. ALL OF THIS IS MEANT TO REASSURE STUDENTS FOLLOWING THE FATAL SHOOTING IN A HALLWAY ON MONDAY.

HICKORY POLICE SEARCH FOR MAN ACCUSED IN FOUR ROBBERIES

HICKORY POLICE ARE LOOKING FOR A MAN THEY BELIEVE IS BEHIND FOUR SEPARATE ARMED ROBBERIES IN THE CITY. THEY SENT CHANNEL NINE THESE SURVEILLANCE PHOTOS. THEY BELIEVE THE MAN ROBBED THESE FOUR STORES BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 4TH AND NOVEMBER 5TH. WITH THE START OF OCTOBER, THE CDC WANTS YOU TO WASH YOUR HANDS AND GET A FLU SHOT. OCTOBER IS USUALLY WHEN THE FLU STARTS TO SPREAD. THE AGENCY'S NEW GUIDELINES SAY ANYONE OLDER THAN SIX-MONTHS-OLD SHOULD GET VACCINATED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. THE OLD GUIDELINES ONLY RECOMMENDED KIDS WHO ARE AT LEAST THREE YEARS OLD GET THE SHOT. LAST YEAR'S FLU SEASON HIT RECORD NUMBERS. THE CDC SAYS NEARLY 80,000 AMERICANS DIED FROM THE DISEASE IN 2017. THAT'S THE HIGHEST DEATH TOLL RECORDED IN FOUR DECADES! IN NORTH CAROLINA -- THERE WERE 389 REPORTED DEATHS. IN SOUTH CAROLINA -- 271 FLU-RELATED DEATHS WERE REPORTED.

STUDY SHOWS MEDICAID INFLUENCES VISITS TO DOCTOR

A NEW REPORT OUT THIS MORNING SHOWS EXPANDING MEDICAID APPEARS TO BE THE DETERMINING FACTOR IN WHETHER POOR PEOPLE GO TO THE DOCTOR. THE GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY OFFICE FOUND ALMOST 20% OF LOW-INCOME PEOPLE IN STATES THAT HAVEN'T EXPANDED MEDICAID PASSED UP NECESSARY MEDICAL CARE. THE CAROLINAS HAVE NOT EXPANDED YET.

PARENTS YOU NEED TO HEAR THIS! THERE HAVE BEEN "MORE" CASES REPORTED OF A RARE POLIO-LIKE ILLNESS IN KIDS... INCLUDING IN THE CAROLINAS! IT'S CALLED ACUTE FLACCID MYELITIS -- OR AFM. MEASLES CASE CONFIRMED IN CAROLINAS

THERE'S A CONFIRMED CASE OF THE MEASLES IN THE CAROLINAS! THE PATIENT LIVES IN SPARTANBURG COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA -- AND RECENTLY TRAVELED OVERSEAS. THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT HAS NOT RELEASED THE PATIENT'S AGE. EARLIER THIS MONTH -- DOCTORS WARNED OF AN OUTBREAK IN EUROPE AND THE POSSIBILITY IT COULD SPREAD HERE.
