Date: 7/16/14 6pm, 9pm, 10pm

Synopsis: POLICE SAY THE VICTIM WAS STABBED MULTIPLE TIMES IN THE NECK AND ARMS ... HE WAS RUSHED TO A HOSPITAL AND IS EXPECTED TO BE OKAY. FRIENDS OF THE VICTIM SAY HE HE'S A HARD WORKER FROM SUDAN. THE PHOTOS ARE AS CLEAR AS SURVEILLANCE PICTURES GET ...THEY'RE FROM METROLINK ... POLICE SAY THIS MAN GOT INTO A CAB FROM THE METROLINK STOP AT LAMBERT AIRPORT THEN HEADED TO ST. CHARLES WHERE POLICE SAY THE SUSPECT TURNED VIOLENT...ATTACKING THE CAB DRIVER WITH A KNIFE. POLICE ARE NOT SURE IF ROBBERY WAS A MOTIVE THEY SAY THE SUSPECT TOOK THE CAB DRIVER'S CELL PHONE AND RAN AWAY AFTER THE CRASH. POLICE BELIEVE THESE PHOTOS WILL HELP.

Synopsis: A ST. LOUIS MAN TODAY WAS RE-SENTENCED TO 19 LIFE SENTENCES PLUS 120 YEARS IN PRISON FOR A 2009 HOME INVASION ROBBERY, KIDNAPPING AND MURDER. LEDALE NATHAN, 16 AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT, HAD AN EARLIER SENTENCE VACATED AFTER A SUPREME COURT RULING BANNED AUTOMATIC LIFE SENTENCES. NOW 20, NATHAN WAS GIVEN 8 ...BACK TO BACK... LIFE SENTENCES, 11 TO BE SERVED CONCURRENTLY, AND AN ADDITIONAL 120 YEARS. THIS FOR SHOOTING ST. LOUIS POLICE OFFICER ISABELLA LOVADINA , INJURING HER BOYFRIEND FIREFIGHTER NICHOLAS KOENIG , AND KILLING KOENIG'S COUSIN, GINA STALLIS IN THE LASALLE PARK NEIGHBORHOOD.

NEAR THE CHEROKEE BUSINESS DISTRICT. THE BOY SUFFERED A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE ARM.... HIS MOTHER WAS HIT IN THE LEG. A 53 YEAR OLD MAN AT THE SCENE WAS SHOT IN THE HEAD. ALL THREE WERE TAKEN TO THE HOSPITAL AND ARE SAID TO BE IN STABLE CONDITION.

Synopsis: BOMMARITO AUTOMOTIVE SKYFOX OVER THE SCENE OF A BANK ROBBERY AT A U-S BANK BRANCH ... INSIDE THE SCHNUCKS ON TELEGRAPH ROAD IN SOUTH COUNTY. IT HAPPENED AROUND 3:15...HERE'S A LOOK AT A SURVEILLANCE IMAGE FROM INSIDE THE BANK. THE SUSPECT IS A WHITE MALE... WEARING A WHITE BASEBALL CAP AND A GRAY LONG SLEEVE T-SHIRT. AUTHORITIES TELL US THE MAN DIDN'T HAVE A WEAPON ... BUT LEFT THE SCENE WITH AN UNDISCLOSED AMOUNT OF CASH. ANYONE WITH INFORMATION SHOULD CALL ST. LOUIS COUNTY POLICE.

Synopsis: A CASE OF ROAD RAGE... ENDS UP WITH A ST. LOUIS MAN FACING ROBBERY AND ASSAULT CHARGES. A WOMAN HIT RANDY CLARK'S CAR ALONG M-L-K DRIVE... THEN HE HIT HER CAR A SHORT TIME LATER AT A HOME. CLARK IS ACCUSED OF THEN... PULLING THE WOMAN OUT OF HER CAR, HITTING HER AND STOMPING ON HER HEAD.... CAUSING BLEEDING ON THE BRAIN. WITNESSES SAY HE ALSO TOOK HER PURSE. Synopsis: ST. LOUIS COUNTY POLICE ARE LOOKING FOR A MAN WHO ROBBED A US BANK, INSIDE A SCHNUCKS STORE. THIS PICTURE IS FROM INSIDE THE STORE ON TELEGRAPH ROAD. POLICE SAY THE MAN WALKED IN AROUND 3:15, DEMANDED MONEY AND LEFT WITH AN UNDISCLOSED AMOUNT OF CASH. AUTHORITIES DID NOT SAY IF HE HAD A WEAPON, BUT NO ONE WAS HURT.

Story: Allen Lawsuit

Synopsis: ST. LOUIS • A and the fact that he was seriously mentally ill and could be easily coerced into a false confession. They coerced him into confessing to the 1982 murder of Mary Bell, hid the exculpatory evidence and fabricated evidence that supported the confession, the suit claims. The claims mirror those that led a Cole County judge in 2012 to void Allen's convictions for murder, rape, sodomy and first-degree burglary and order his release from prison. Circuit Judge Daniel Green criticized a 'deeply flawed' interrogation that led to a 'dubious' confession and said police ignored and hid evidence pointing to a perpetrator other than Allen. The suit was filed in U.S. District Court here by Allen and his mother against St. Louis, police officials and police officers and employees by lawyers with Bryan Cave and the Innocence Project who helped secure Allen's release.

Story: Running Adds Years to Life

Synopsis: Runners may live an average three years longer than people who don't run, according to new research.But, the best news from this study is that it appears that you can reap this benefit even if you run at slow speeds for mere minutes every day, the 15-year study suggests. "People may not need to run a lot to get health benefits," said lead author Duck-chul Lee, an assistant professor of kinesiology at Iowa State University. "I hope this study can motivate more people to start running and to continue running as an attainable health goal."

There could be other reasons that runners live longer. It could be that healthy people are the ones who choose to run, noted the study's authors.
