

But what about the other 5 percent? That can include synthetics... like xanthan gum, an artificial thickener and ethylene, a chemical used in storing fruit. A total of 38 synthetic ingredients can be included in that 5 percent. {GRAPHIC 2}

Now.. a new federal amendment passed by Congress last month would allow even more synthetics. That has many in the organic industry seeing red.. not green.

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
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


