



JONATHAN: "We got calls from Chicago right away telling us a plane had hit. No one knew what was going on... a lot of confusion. "

"Part of the memorial should have a place for people who survived so they can go to I think it's important for them to be there."

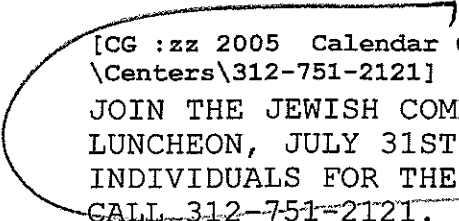
