Job Fair on 3/27/15:

KSCI participated in the 4th Annual Hiring JobKoreausa.com and JobAsiaUSA job fair sponsored by the Korean American Chamber of Commerce Los Angeles. It provides a diversity of Asian job applicants looking for jobs that will allow them to use their Asian background. KSCI staffed a booth to meet with job candidates and collect prospective job candidate's information for current and future job openings. The career fair was attended d by the Director of Community Relations and our Korean Sales executive.

Initiative Section 73.2080(c)(2)(v) - Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

August 2014:

KSCI hosted a student from USC who was involved with Filipino programming and the production of foreign language content. Station staff involved in the instruction was the Director of Station Production, Producer Kababayan Today and Producer of the show Halo Halo.

October 2014:

KSCI hosted a student from USC who was involved with the Chinese programming in developing an understanding of programming at an Asian language TV station.

December 2014:

KSCI hosted a student from University of California at Los Angeles who was involved with the Marketing and Research in learning digital platforms maintenance and promotions.

December 2014:

KSCI hosted a student from USC who was involved with the Chinese news department in learning skills as a Mandarin News Reporter.

February 2015:

KSCI hosted a student from USC who was involved with the Chinese programming in developing an understanding of programming at an Asian language TV station. May 2015:

KSCI hosted a student from UCLA who was involved with the Tagalong programming in developing skills for closed captioning and editing of Filipino programming.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(vii) - Participation in scholarship programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting.

Scholarship May 2015:

KSCI produced a PSA in three different languages (Mandarin, Korean and Tagalog) announcing the opportunity to submit applications for 110 scholarships of \$3,000 each to be awarded in four categories, African American Future Achievers, Asian Pacific American Students Increasing Achievement, Hispanic American Commitment to Education Resources, and Asian Scholars. KSCI broadcasts those three PSA's for three weeks in advance of the scholarship application deadline to make the Asian community aware of the scholarship opportunity. A KSCI employee participated on the evaluation committee reading scholarship applications, essays and judging those entries to finalize the scholarship winners. KSCI participates at the awards ceremony and meets and congratulates all the Asian scholarship winners. After the awards ceremony KSCI produced a PSA in three different languages (Mandarin, Korean and Tagalog) announcing the winners and congratulating all of the participants. The three PSA's were broadcast on KSCI for a three week period after the awards ceremony to announce the winners and congratulate all of the participants

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(viii) – Establishment of training programs designated to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions.

September 2014:

Employee in the Production Department completed an on line training course on the subject of Animating Logos in After Effects.

December 2014:

Two employees in the Production Department completed two on line training courses. The courses were Animation Typography in After Effects and the other was Project Management Simplified and Managing Project Quality.

April 2015:

The Production Manager completed an on line training

course on Managing Technical Teams.

April 2015:

Two employees in the Editing Department completed two on line training courses. The courses were After Effects Tips and Techniques and Advanced Photoshop

Techniques.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(xii) — Listing of each upper-level category opening in a job bank or newsletter of media trade groups whose membership includes substantial participation of women and minorities.

KSCI lists all job openings in the newsletters of the Asian American Journalists Association, the Asian American media studies at USC and the Asian American media studies at UCLA.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(xiv) – Provision of training to management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination.

May 2015:

KSCI trained all management personnel to prevent harassment and promote equal opportunities through an on line training program that included testing, case studies and policy review. The training included training managers in recognizing harassment and discrimination, handling these types of complaints and retaliation.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(xvi) - Participation in other activities designed by the station employment unit reasonably calculated to further the goal of disseminating information as to employment opportunities in broadcasting to job candidates who might otherwise be unaware of such opportunities.

Job Bank:

KSCI posts job openings with many different organizations in the stations coverage area with over half of those posting with organizations centered on women or minority based membership. KSCI also posts job openings on internet job listings sites such as Craigslist, Monster, California Broadcasters Association and the Society of Broadcasting Engineers and the TV stations website LA18.com.
