The Stations public relations manager spoke to students ages 16 to 17 at the Patti and Peter Neuwirth leadership Academy on the direction necessary for education to enter the journalism and broadcasting field of employment post college.

¹ The KSCI Station Employment Unit includes commonly-controlled TV stations KSCI, KNLA-CD, KNET-CD and KSKJ-CD. Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(iv) Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions.

Job Fair on 4/22/17:

KSCI attended the Annual Chinese Career Center 4th bilingual Job and Career Fair. The job fair was attended by our Director of Community Relations. KSCI staffed a booth to meet with job candidates and collect prospective job candidate's information for current and future job openings. The career fair was attended d by the Director of Community Relations.

Job Fair on 5/19/17:

KSCI participated in the 5th Annual Hiring JobKoreausa.com and JobAsiaUSA job fair sponsored by the Korean American Chamber of Commerce Los Angeles. It provides a diversity of Asian job applicants looking for jobs that will allow them to use their Asian background. KSCI staffed a booth to meet with job candidates and collect prospective job candidate's information for current and future job openings. The career fair was attended d by the Director of Community Relations and our Korean Sales executive.

Initiative Section 73.2080(c)(2)(v) - Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

August 2016:

KSCI hosted a student from USC who was involved with Mandarin news programming in teaching them how to develop writing skills for live news casts and performing live interviews in the field.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(vi) - Participation in job banks, Internet programs, and other programs designed to promote outreach generally.

Panel Discussion June 2017:

Stations Social media and Filipino co-producer/reporter participated in a panel discussion hosted by the Society of Professional Journalists regarding whether television reporters can also be political activists.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(vii) - Participation in scholarship programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting.

Scholarship May 2017:

KSCI produced and aired PSA's in three different languages (Mandarin, Korean and Tagalog) announcing the opportunity to submit applications for Ronald McDonald House Charities (RMHC) of Southern California's Asian-Pacific American Students Increasing Achievement Scholarship. The charity is

awarding \$42,000 in scholarships through the program. KSCI aired the PSA's three weeks prior to the scholarship application deadline, raising awareness of this scholarship opportunity to the Asian community. Two KSCI employees are members of the RMHC/ASIA Educational Advisory Board, and participated in meetings to select scholarship winners. KSCI reps also attend the awards ceremony and meet/congratulate all the Asian scholarship winners.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(viii) – Establishment of training programs designated to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions.

September 2, 2016:

Employees in the production department received training from an outside expert on how to run a live crawl in the lower 1/3 of the video frame during a live telethon to show donors, donation amounts, and donors challenges to others.

October 2016 to March 2017:

News/television producers received Pilot training on a commercial Drone from a licensed Drone Pilot. Instruction included regulations, laws, airport operations, maintenance and emergency procedures.

January 2017 to April 2017:

Provided training to our receptionist on various editing techniques to improve the quality of the editing and the quantity.

January 2017 to March 2017:

Provided training to our part time receptionist to learn how to operate a studio camera and computer graphics software in the news room.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(xii) – Listing of each upper-level category opening in a job bank or newsletter of media trade groups whose membership includes substantial participation of women and minorities.

KSCI lists all job openings in the newsletters of the Asian American Journalists Association, the Asian American media studies at USC and the Asian American media studies at UCLA and in on-line job banks for the California Broadcasters Association.

Initiative: Section 73.2080(c)(2)(xvi) - Participation in other activities designed by the station employment unit reasonably calculated to further the goal of disseminating information as to employment opportunities in broadcasting to job candidates who might otherwise be unaware of such opportunities.

Job Bank:

KSCI posts job openings with many different organizations in

the stations coverage area with over half of those posting with organizations centered on women or minority based membership. KSCI also posts job openings on internet job listings sites such as Craigslist, Monster, California Broadcasters Association and the Society of Broadcasting Engineers and the TV stations website LA18.com.
