

The primary signal of a station may complete its Children's CORE obligation by airing either (i) three (3) hours per week (as averaged over a six-month period) of CORE Programming, or (ii) 156 hours of CORE Programming annually, including at least 26 hours per quarter of regularly scheduled weekly programming of at least 30 minutes in length and up to 52 hours annually of CORE Programs of at least 30 minutes in length that are not aired on a regularly scheduled weekly basis, such as educational specials and regularly scheduled non-weekly programming, and/or other non-regularly scheduled programming and short-form programming, such as PSAs and interstitials. The primary signal of a station may complete its Children's CORE obligation by airing either (i) three (3) hours per week (as averaged over a six-month period) of CORE Programming, or (ii) 156 hours of CORE Programming annually, including at least 26 hours per quarter of regularly scheduled weekly programming of at least 30 minutes in length and up to 52 hours annually of CORE Programs of at least 30 minutes in length that are not aired on a regularly scheduled weekly basis, such as educational specials and regularly scheduled non-weekly programming, and/or

other non-regularly scheduled programming and short-form programming, such as PSAs and interstitials.
