We are in receipt of your letter requesting mandatory carriage for KTUZ-TV in the Oklahoma City, Oklahoma local market.

DIRECTV will continue carriage of KTUZ-TV in the Oklahoma City, Oklahoma local market on January 1, 2009 in accordance with Section 338 of the Communications Act of 1934 and the Federal Communications Commission's Rules.

In connection with the pending digital transition, DIRECTV has already converted the signals in the Oklahoma City, Oklahoma local market area from analog to standard definition digital. As such, DIRECTV will continue to carry a standard definition version of KTUZ-TV's digital signal until such time as DIRECTV offers local signals in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on an "HD carry-one, carry-all" basis, as contemplated in the Commission's recent *Digital Carriage Order*. See *Carriage of Digital Television Broadcast Signals: Amendment to Part 76 of the Commission's Rules*; 23 FCC Rcd. 5351 (2008).
