Dear Mr. Walsh:

On June 14, 2004, on behalf of Shawnee Broadcasting, Inc. ("Shawnee Broadcasting"), licensee of station KQOK-TV, Shawnee, Oklahoma, you filed must carry complaints against Cox Communications, Inc. ("Cox") seeking carriage of KQOK on its cable systems serving Pawhuska, Blackwell, Stillwater, Perkins, Perry, Enid, North Enid, Vance AFB, certain unincorporated areas of Garfield County, and certain unincorporated areas of Noble County, Oklahoma.

Subsequently, on August 2, 2004, you informed the Commission that Shawnee Broadcasting requests that the petitions be dismissed because it is no longer wants KQOK to be carried on Cox's cable systems serving the above-referenced communities.

In view of the foregoing, pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's rules, the petitions filed on June 14, 2004, are hereby dismissed.
