## **Fourth Quarter**

#### **Issue: Money and Finances**

At 6:00 for 30 minutes we sponsored a call in program to a panel financial experts to address all aspect of family and business finances.

#### Issue: Overcoming Trauma

October 24 we aired a talk by Dr. Elizabeth Stevens at 8:00 for 25 minutes. She was a highachieving psychiatrist in the U.S. Air Force. Her work came to an abrupt halt when she was debilitated by a traumatic brain injury and a series of other traumatic events which caused PTSD. In this conversation, Dr. Stevens offered hope to those who are bound by the pain of trauma.

#### **Issue: Suffering**

October 25 We broadcast a narrative by Dr. Gary Oliver about a 4 year period in which he survived eight cancer surgeries and the removal of 80 percent of his tongue, he buried his father, his son, his only sibling, and his wife. He spoke of the grief and how he has found peace at 9:30 for 25 minutes.

#### **Issue: Foster Care**

November 1 At 8:00 for 25 minutes we ran an interview with Ryan Bomberger, founder of The Radiance Foundation, and he revealed important research on abortion and adoption, and he explained why more people should explore adoption from foster care.

#### **Issue: Faith and Politics**

November 4 We carried a discussion with Samuel Rodriguez, president of the National Hispanic Christian Leadership Conference about the importance of the Hispanic vote and turnout for the upcoming election at 9:30 for 25 minutes

## Issue: Money/debt

November 7 at 8:30 for 25 minutes we shared the account of Bob Lotich and his wife Linda as they told their story of going from broke to smart money management; Paying off 400k in debt and giving away \$1 million at 8:30 for 25 minutes

# **Issue: Forgiveness**

November 22 Carried a talk with Dr. Tim Keller as he shared stories of forgiveness and shared how to help you forgive those who've wronged you. Dr. Keller discussed the steps to forgiveness, and how to lovingly confront others at 8:00 for 25 minutes

## **Issue: Addiction**

December 1 We aired an interview with Ron & Nan Deal, who began their marriage with issues that spiraled after the loss of their 12-year-old. They shared their story of grief, addiction, & the road to hope and recovery at 8:30 for 25 minutes

# Issue: Depression/Isolation

December 15 At 8:30 for 25 minutes we broadcast an interview with author Heather Holleman, who proposed ways to combat loneliness and develop relationships.

# **Issue: Adoption and Abortion**

December 21 We ran an interview with Melissa Ohden, director of Abortions Survivors Network, at 9:30 for 25 minutes where Melissa recounted how she was born alive after an attempted late term saline abortion failed to kill her. After her birth, she was adopted, and as she grew older, she was able to reunite with her birth parents.

## Issue: Fear and Worry

December 22 We played a talk with Dr. Josh and Christi Straub at 8:00 for 25 minutes, and they described how to identify emotions and navigate fear and worry in a healthy way.
