On behalf of Liberty University, Inc. ("Liberty"), licensee of the NCE-FM stations listed below, this is to advise you that copies of the public inspection files for those stations will no longer be maintained in their communities of license. The affected stations are as follows:

WVRA, Enfield, North Carolina, Fac. ID 164202
WVRD, Zebulon, North Carolina, Fac. ID 41094
WVRH, Norlina, North Carolina, Fac. ID 1208
WVRL, Elizabeth City, North Carolina, Fac. ID 86560
WVRP, Roanoke Rapids, North Carolina, Fac. ID 85603
WVRS, Gore, Virginia, Fac. ID 122630
WVRI, Clifton Forge, Virginia 177072

All of the listed stations have been granted waivers of Section 73.1125(a) of the rules pertaining to main studio location. In each waiver request, Liberty made a commitment to make a copy of the station's public file available in the community of license. But Liberty has had few, if any, requests from members of the public to view its local public inspection files, and the FCC now considers the maintenance of local files as optional. Accordingly, effective immediately, Liberty will no longer maintain public files in the communities of license of the stations listed above. It will, however, continue to maintain complete public files at the waived stations' main studios, which are co-located with those of Station WRVL, Lynchburg, Virginia, and continue to provide a toll-free telephone number to Lynchburg from each community of license.
