On behalf of the Regents of the University of Michigan (the "University"), licensee of noncommercial educational radio station WFUM-FM, Flint, Michigan, we hereby re-submit, out of an abundance of caution, the enclosed notification of the commencement of digital broadcasting using iBiquity Digital Corporation's HD Radio TM technology.

As evidenced by the enclosed date-stamped copy of WFUM-FM's digital notification filing, the University originally filed this notice with the Commission on November 14, 2005, consistent with the Commission's order on interim digital operations in *Digital Audio Broadcasting Systems and Their Impact on the Terrestrial Radio Broadcast Service*, MM Docket No. 99-325, *First Report and Order* (October 11, 2002). However, a recent review of the Commission's CDBS records indicates that receipt of this notification is not currently reflected by that database. The University therefore re-submits the attached date-stamped copy of this filing, and respectfully requests that the Commission update its records accordingly.

The University is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates Station WFUM-FM on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, the University qualifies as governmental entity.
