### INITIATIVES

The employment unit engaged in the following broad outreach initiatives in accordance with various elements of FCC Rule 73.2080(c)(2):

Establishment of an **internship** program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

#### AARP Foundation – SCSEP:

KIXE acts as a host agency training site for the AARP SCSEP Training Program. This program offers job training, job placement, and work experience to workers over the age of 55. It's designed to help seniors enter the workforce, find more challenging positions, change careers, or supplement their income. This fiscal year three (3) participants were assigned in the program at KIXE as front desk/receptionist working a combined total of 2,768 training hours.

#### <u>Senior Corps – RSVP Volunteer Program</u>

The Senior Corps, Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) is a volunteer network for people 55 and over. RSVP volunteers are matched with local organizations, allowing them to use the skills and talents they've learned over the years, or develop new ones while serving in a variety of volunteer activities within the community. This fiscal year three (3) participants were assigned in the program at KIXE.

Participated in **job fairs** by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in making hiring decisions.

#### Tehama County Chamber of Commerce Business Expo – February 23, 2023

The Director of Development & Marketing, the Volunteer & Outreach Coordinator, and the Corporate & Community Engagement Rep. attended the event with a booth. This business expo is free to the public and is the largest business trade show event in Tehama County, featuring more than 80 vendors from all categories of businesses, organizations, and events. It gives the opportunity for local businesses to highlight what they have to offer the community and connects potential employers and employees.

### AmeriCorps Seniors of Northern CA/Dignity Health Volunteer Fair – July 13, 2023

The volunteer fair provided seniors over the age of 55 with volunteering information and allowed them to fill out volunteer applications with different businesses and organizations. The Director of Development & Marketing attended the event and hosted a table that provided information on volunteer opportunities at the station.

### Community Foundation of the North State – August 17, 2022 & May 30, 2023

The Director of Engineering & Technology attended two ETAC Webinars; Cybersecurity Incident Preparedness & Response with the FBI and CISA on December 14, 2022, and Stations FCC Filings on October 18, 2022.

The TV Tech Summit highlighted the newest technologies that are transforming the business and revolutionizing how television is produced and distributed, subjects included news and sports production, AI, NextGen TV/ATSC 3.0, remote production, cloud-based workflows and 5G. #### Public Media Technology Summit – April 13-14, 2023 Las Vegas NV

The Public Media Technology Summit included sessions on RF, IT and general technology practice and management—particularly as they intersect with ATSC 3.0/NextGen TV, IP-based facilities, cloud-based production, and the related business and service opportunities that support public media's unique mission. ### 2023 PBS Annual Meeting - May 15 - 17, 2023 San Diego CA
