KUNM programs are produced in our studios in Onate Hall on the University of New Mexico's main campus in Albuquerque. These programs are also broadcast at the same time on our stations KRAR (Española), KRRE (Las Vegas), KRRT (Taos) and KBOM (Socorro) as well as several low-power translator stations in the region.

Programs and agreements:

KUNM has always featured a diverse programming lineup. Many of our programs are produced locally by our talented team of professional staff, student interns, and community volunteers.

Other programs are acquired from program producers across the country. Our acquired programs typically have an annual agreement that lays out the costs and terms for our local broadcast of the programs. These agreements vary in length and complexity. And, they don't all renew at the same time. Some programs (New Dimensions, Alternative Radio, Counterspin) don't have costs or agreements.
