January 7, 2024

Cobb County Fire Department

Spoke with requirement officer explaining how to apply in the upcoming open session on becoming the Cobb County Fire Department.

Spoke about the 12 weeks of training. Recruits will have both classroom instruction and hands on training in a field environment. At the end of the 12 weeks the testing will begin on all levels of firefighting and prevention.

Meals on Wheels

Meals On Wheels Atlanta (MOWA) was founded in 1965 to support seniors struggling with poverty, food insecurity, and social isolation. Over more than 50 years, they have grown from a small soup kitchen to an organization serving 347,000 meals each year throughout the Atlanta area.

They have also expanded their program offerings to respond to other critical needs in our community. They now offer multiple services to support both older adults and veterans, including home-delivered and congregate meals, home repair services, and an emergency food pantry.

We spoke with the CEO and Hillary Baker about the benefits of meals on wheels and how they benefit our community. They do amazing things for senior citizens; they repair homes and make some delicious pecans. Those proceeds go right back to helping feed the community.

Coats for Kids/Georgia Knights of Columbus

Spoke with Bishop Boland on the wonderful program to supply coats for kids in Atlanta & other Georgia Regional sections. February 4, 2024

Fulton County Free Rides for seniors

Allen D'Alessandro regional manager of operations/Fulton Country spoke about the Uber/Lyft program that provides transportation to eligible Fulton County seniors who are 60 years old and above. If you are eligible, you will pay a one-time registration fee in the amount of \$15. Seniors must have a credit card, debit card, or prepaid debit card on file to pay a \$1 per ride charge. This charge is billed monthly. Participants may have no more than 16 rides per month with mileage limits of 15 miles for medical appointments and 10 miles for other trips (shopping, banking, social activities, etc.).

February 11, 2024

Cobb County Books for Kids

Lori Frasca spoke about there are more than 50,000 children under age 5 in Cobb County. The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommends reading and engaging in conversations regularly with young children to encourage brain development and strengthen parent-child relationships to build language, literacy, and social-emotional skills that last a lifetime.

Habitat for Humanity

Habitat for Humanity works in more than 70 countries — we have helped more than 46 million people improve their living conditions since 1976.

Habitat works together with families, local communities, volunteers and partners from around the world so that more people are able to live in affordable and safe homes. Our advocacy efforts focus on policy reform to remove systemic barriers preventing low-income and historically underserved families from accessing adequate, affordable shelter.

Marta Free Rides for Students & Seniors

Schools in Metro Atlanta and the surrounding communities can partner with MARTA to provide their students with safe, reliable transportation. We offer discounted 10-Trip Student Breeze Passes to schools throughout the area that are valid weekdays on all of our buses and trains.

Although MARTA sells the passes, each school participating in the program sets up its own payment policy — whether they charge a fee for each pass or offer them to students for free.

March 4, 2024

Speech Therapy Atlanta

We were alerted that Sage Speech & Learning Associates offer free classes to help with stuttering and speech therapy. Serving Atlanta, Brookhaven, Sandy Springs, Dunwoody and surrounding areas. Teams also spoke about how to become a trusted partner.
