### ***STUDENT INTERNSHIPS and TRAINING PROGRAMS***

The Station offers the following ongoing recruitment programs for various entry-level opportunities:

#### **Six Month Training Program**

FOX 5/WNYW and MY 9/WWOR offers a hands-on Six Month Training Program for college graduates interested in obtaining valuable experience in the various fields of Television Broadcasting. This training program requires no previous broadcast work experience, thereby, when the six-months training period is completed, the goal is to provide the trainee with the prerequisite skills to acquire an entry-level position in the broadcasting field.

The Six Month Training Program is offered in various departments, including News, Good Day New York, Production/Engineering, Sales and Community Affairs.

#### **Internship Program**

FOX 5/WNYW and MY 9/WWOR has an ongoing Internship program for college juniors and seniors majoring in broadcast communications and/or journalism as well as other areas. Individuals have the opportunity to learn from trained professionals in various departments, including News, Good Day New York, Community Affairs, Sales, Sports, Creative Services, FOX Stations Sales and Human Resources. Candidates must be eligible to receive academic credit in order to be eligible for the program.

WNYW and WWOR provided internships to 46 students for academic credit during the semesters from Spring 2015 through Fall 2016. The students interned in News, Sports, Human Resources, Good Day New York, Sales, Creative Services, FOX Stations Sales and Community Affairs. The interns included students from Villanova University, American University, John Jay College of Criminal Justice, Syracuse University, Quinnipiac University, SUNY Cortlandt, Susquehanna University, Bard College, Kings College, University of Notre Dame, Lafayette College, High Point University, Molloy College, Fairfield University, Elon University, Lim College, Seton Hall University, Boston University, Miami University, Rollins College, Sacred Heart University, Montclair State University, SUNY Oswego, SUNY Binghamton, Yale University, Washington & Lee University, University of Maryland, University of Michigan, St. Francis College, Gill St. Bernard School, Rutgers University, College of Mt. St. Vincent, CUNY Queens College, New Jersey City University, Monmouth University and Iona College.

- Q & A Session with WWOR VP/Station Manager - A Question and Answer Session was held with Dianne Doctor, WWOR VP/Station Manager on March 31, 2015, to learn more about developing a career path, what makes news, what news directors look for in a candidate and what skills are needed to become a reporter or producer. Attended by Roselyn Barranda, HR Director and students from Iona College, Montclair State University, News and Good Day New York trainees, in addition FOX Stations Sales staff.
- Intern Discussion with VP/News Director - An intern and trainee discussion was held with Byron Harmon, VP/News Director on August 4, 2015, to learn more about career paths and opportunities. ## ***MENTORING and SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS***

The Stations also participate regularly in career mentoring and scholarship programs at schools and universities. Examples of such events during the period above include:

- **PENCIL Fellows Program**

Fox Television Stations is involved in an educational partnership with PENCIL and the Department of Education's Virtual Enterprises program. This program provides successful career-minded New York City public high school juniors and seniors with dynamic experimental learning experiences through full-time paid summer internships at the stations.

The Station hosted a PENCIL fellow from Queens High School for the Sciences at York College from 7/6/15 – 8/24/15 who gained valuable career experience in the areas of Human Resources, FOX Stations Sales, Finance, Engineering/Production, Good Day New York, News, Creative Services and Community Affairs.

- **Emma L. Bowen Foundations for Minority Interests in Media**

Established in 1989, the Emma L Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create career opportunities in the media industry for minority youth through a program that focuses on scholastic achievement, direct work experience and professional development. Students in the program work in media companies each summer and during school breaks, from high school through college. The students earn both salaries and matching scholarship funds to be used for college tuition and related expenses. Over a period of up to five years, the students experience numerous aspects of corporate operation and develop professional and practical skills that will help prepare them for their careers, many of which begin at the companies where the student interned. Fox Television Stations have been a corporate partner in this program since its inception and two of the Company's executives are on the Foundation's Board.

As a result of WNYW & WWOR's participation as a Media Partner in the program, many students have obtained training and staff jobs as well as funding for their college and university education.

The Station and FOX Stations Sales hosted four (4) students from the program throughout the year from American University, Rutgers University, Stonybrook University and Quinnipiac University. The students worked in FOX Stations Sales, Human Resources and Community Affairs.

Additionally, a Student Presentation was conducted on 7/28/15 on "Sales & Social Media." Presentations were attended by Roselyn Barranda, HR Director, Dorian Kasuba, HR Director, Byron Harmon, VP/News Director, Lamar Goering, Executive Producer, Matt Ohnemus, Design Director, Ken Ashley, Promotions Manager, Dan Carlin, VP/Programming & Research, Elizabeth Pritchard, VP/Training & Development and students from American University, Rutgers University and Queens High School for the Sciences.

- **American Corporate Partners (ACP)**

21<sup>st</sup> Century FOX participates in ACP's Veteran Mentoring Program connects Veteran Protégés with Corporate Mentors for a yearlong mentorship. Paired based on their career objectives and professional experience, Mentors and Protégés define the goals of their mentorship together and focus on a successful transition from the military to the civilian workforce through training, coaching and job development skills.

Station personnel serving as Mentors in the program are Joe Oulvey, SVP/FOX Stations Sales to one (1) Protégé from the U.S. Army.

- **21CF "Adopted High school" Program**

21<sup>st</sup> Century FOX participates in the Adopted High School Program with FOX 5/WNYW and Bishop Kearny High School in learning more about production operations within the studio/control room and newsroom operations and their academic goals within their school television station.

- **Fountain House Transitional Employment Program**

WNYW participates in the on-going transitional employment program with Fountain House, an organization that works within the mental health community, in their transition back into the workplace. Individuals work for six to nine months within the Station. The objective of the program is to break the negative stereotypes and debilitating stigma that surround the label of mental illness; in addition to helping those individuals regain their self-esteem, self-confidence and a sense of purpose in preparing them to pursue an outside paying job.

The Station currently employs four (4) individuals from the program.

## ***TRAINING and PROMOTIONS***

WNYW and WWOR encourage employees to apply for promotions for which they are qualified. In an effort to increase internal promotions, the station offers many internal cross-training opportunities. This enables the employees to acquire the necessary skills and experience needed to be considered for advancement opportunities. The Station has trained and promoted internally from the following programs:

### **Sales Training Program**

FOX Stations Sales, an in-house sales organization maintains a program to train new Account Executives with the overall goal of providing an internal pool of talent for future Account Executive positions within FOX Television Stations and FOX Stations Sales. This program consists of both coursework and hands-on training. At the end of the program, individuals are assigned to Stations and sales offices throughout the United States. This program is overseen by Elizabeth Pritchard, FSS VP of Training & Development & Dorian Kasuba, and FSS HR Director.

Station participation is active during the program through various workshop sessions and training meetings:

- National Sales Department – Trainees listened in on a national negotiation between the NSM, Walter Augustin, and the FSS Atlanta office.
- Digital Sales – Trainees met with Cindy D'Ambrosio and went through her digital capabilities deck for WNYW.
- Traffic Department – Trainees met with Violet Chew, Traffic Director, and learned about log assembly and editing.
- News Department – Trainees met with Byron Harmon, News Director, and watched the 5PM News in the studio and toured the Control Room.
- Programming, Research & Creative Services – Trainees met with Dan Carlin to discuss station programming and research and to learn about promotional effort, and digital/social media metrics.

Graduates from the program this year were assigned to FOX Television Stations in New York, Philadelphia, Detroit and Atlanta.
